CALL TO WORSHIP AND INVOCATION: EXODUS 25.21-22

And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee. <sup>22</sup> And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubims which *are* upon the ark of the testimony, of all *things* which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel.

<sup>1</sup> And God spake all these words, saying, <sup>2</sup> I *am* the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. <sup>3</sup> Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

<sup>4</sup> Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness *of any thing* that *is* in heaven above, or that *is* in the earth beneath, or that *is* in the water under the earth: <sup>5</sup> Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate me; <sup>6</sup> And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

<sup>7</sup> Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

<sup>8</sup> Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. <sup>9</sup> Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: <sup>10</sup> But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates: <sup>11</sup> For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

<sup>12</sup> Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

<sup>13</sup> Thou shalt not kill.

<sup>14</sup> Thou shalt not commit adultery.

<sup>15</sup> Thou shalt not steal.

<sup>16</sup> Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

<sup>17</sup> Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that *is* thy neighbour's.

## QUESTION 25: WHEREIN CONSISTETH THE SINFULNESS OF THAT ESTATE WHEREINTO MAN FELL?

### ANSWER:

THE SINFULNESS OF THAT ESTATE WHEREINTO MAN FELL, CONSISTETH IN THE GUILT OF ADAM'S FIRST SIN,<sup>A</sup> THE WANT OF THAT RIGHTEOUSNESS WHEREIN HE WAS CREATED, AND THE CORRUPTION OF HIS NATURE, WHEREBY HE IS UTTERLY INDISPOSED, DISABLED, AND MADE OPPOSITE UNTO ALL THAT IS SPIRITUALLY GOOD, AND WHOLLY INCLINED TO ALL EVIL, AND THAT CONTINUALLY;<sup>B</sup> WHICH IS COMMONLY CALLED ORIGINAL SIN, AND FROM WHICH DO PROCEED ALL ACTUAL TRANSGRESSIONS.<sup>C</sup>
