Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

- What are "these thing" (9-10) that Nicodemus and Jesus are speaking about? Therefore what were Jesus and Nicodemus talking about in this passage?
- What are the "earthly things" and "heavenly things" (12) to which Jesus is referring?
- According to v. 13, what qualifies Jesus more than any other person to speak on "these things"?
- What is the comparison Jesus is making in v.14? Who is the "Son of Man"? What is implied in His being "lifted up"?
- What is the result of the Son of Man being lifted up?
- What is meant by "eternal life"?
- From the further explanation in verse 16-21, what greater clarity surfaces as to how these thing can be?
- Community Group Discussion: What is revealed about Jesus in His encounter with Nicodemus? What do you better understand about faith by your careful consideration of this passage?
