

The Difficulty of Preaching part 3

The propensity for listeners to turn away from the truth **2 Timothy 4:3-4** Chris Mueller 1-27-2019

Introduction:

2 Timothy 4:1 I solemnly charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom: **2** preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction. **3** For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but wanting to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires, **4** and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths. **5** But you, be sober in all things, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.

3 For the time **WILL come** when they **WILL** not **endure sound** doctrine; but wanting to have their **EARS tickled**, they **WILL accumulate** for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires, **4** and **WILL turn away** their **EARS** from the truth and **WILL turn aside** to myths.

1 Timothy 1:9-10 lawless and rebellious...ungodly and sinners...unholy and profane...murderers and immoral men and homosexuals and kidnappers and liars and perjurers [living lives that are] contrary to sound teaching.

1 Timothy 6:3-5 If anyone advocates a different doctrine, and does not agree with sound words, those of our Lord Jesus Christ, and with the doctrine conforming to godliness, he is conceited and understands nothing; but he has a morbid interest in controversial questions and disputes about words, out of which arise envy, strife, abusive language, evil suspicions, and constant friction between men of depraved mind and deprived of the truth, who suppose that godliness is a means of gain.

2 Timothy 1:13-14 Retain the standard of sound words which you have heard from me...Guard, through the Holy Spirit who dwells in us, the treasure which has been entrusted to you.

STEP 2 – **E** _____ your own decisions and desires **3b-4a** (active voice)

John Calvin Shall heap up to themselves teachers. It is proper to observe the expression, heap up, by which he means that the madness of men will be so great, that they will not be satisfied with a few deceivers, but will desire to have a vast multitude.
