1 Corinthians 15:21 For since by a man came death, by a man also came the resurrection of the dead. 22 For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all will be made alive.

Romans 5:12 Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned;

Genesis 6:5 Then the LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great on the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

Psalm 14:1 The fool has said in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, they have committed abominable deeds; There is no one who does good. 2 The LORD has looked down from heaven upon the sons of men To see if there are any who understand, Who seek after God. 3 They have all turned aside, together they have become corrupt; There is no one who does good, not even one.

Romans 3:9 What then? Are we better than they? Not at all; for we have already charged that both Jews and Greeks are all under sin; 10 as it is written,

[Psalm 14] "THERE IS NONE RIGHTEOUS, NOT EVEN ONE; 11 THERE IS NONE WHO UNDERSTANDS, THERE IS NONE WHO SEEKS FOR GOD; 12 ALL HAVE TURNED ASIDE, TOGETHER THEY HAVE BECOME USELESS; THERE IS NONE WHO DOES GOOD, THERE IS NOT EVEN ONE."

[Psalm 5:9] 13 "THEIR THROAT IS AN OPEN GRAVE,
[Psalm 140:3] WITH THEIR TONGUES THEY KEEP DECEIVING," "THE POISON OF ASPES IS UNDER THEIR LIPS";
[Psalm 10:7] 14 "WHOSE MOUTH IS FULL OF CURSING AND BITTERNESS";

[Isaiah 59:7-8] 15 “THEIR FEET ARE SWIFT TO SHED BLOOD,
16 DESTRUCTION AND MISERY ARE IN THEIR PATHS, 17
AND THE PATH OF PEACE THEY HAVE NOT KNOWN.”
[Psalm 36:1] 18 “THERE IS NO FEAR OF GOD BEFORE THEIR
EYES.”

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of
God, 24 being justified as a gift by His grace through the
redemption which is in Christ Jesus;

Psalm 51:5 Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, And in sin
my mother conceived me.

Romans 8:8 and those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

Hebrews 11:6 . . . without faith, it is impossible to please God. . .

Ephesians 2:1 And you were dead in your trespasses and sins, 2
in which you formerly walked according to the course of this
world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the
spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience. 3 Among
them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging
the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature
children of wrath, even as the rest. 4 But God, being rich in
mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, 5 even
when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together
with Christ (by grace you have been saved), 6 and raised us up
with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in
Christ Jesus, 7 so that in the ages to come He might show the
surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ
Jesus. 8 For by grace you have been saved through faith; and
that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God;

Colossians 2:13 When you were dead in your transgressions and
the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together
with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions, 14 having

canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against
us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way,
having nailed it to the cross.

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of
God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Isaiah 46:10 “My purpose will be established, And I will
accomplish all My good pleasure.”

Malachi 1:2 “I have loved you,” says the LORD. But you say,
“How have You loved us?” “Was not Esau Jacob’s brother?”
declares the LORD. “Yet I have loved Jacob; 3 but I have hated
Esau, and I have made his mountains a desolation and appointed
his inheritance for the jackals of the wilderness.”

Roman 9:9 For this is the word of promise: “AT THIS TIME I WILL
COME, AND SARAH SHALL HAVE A SON.” 10 And not only
this, but there was Rebekah also, when she had conceived twins by
one man, our father Isaac; 11 for though the twins were not yet born
and had not done anything good or bad, so that God’s purpose
according to His choice would stand, not because of works but
because of Him who calls, 12 it was said to her, “THE OLDER WILL
SERVE THE YOUNGER.” 13 Just as it is written, “JACOB I
LOVED, BUT ESAU I HATED.” 14 What shall we say then? There
is no injustice with God, is there? May it never be! 15 For He says to
Moses, “I WILL HAVE MERCY ON WHOM I HAVE MERCY,
AND I WILL HAVE COMPASSION ON WHOM I HAVE
COMPASSION.” 16 So then it does not depend on the man who wills
or the man who runs, but on God who has mercy. 17 For the Scripture
says to Pharaoh, “FOR THIS VERY PURPOSE I RAISED YOU UP,
TO DEMONSTRATE MY POWER IN YOU, AND THAT MY
NAME MIGHT BE PROCLAIMED THROUGHOUT THE WHOLE
EARTH.” 18 So then He has mercy on whom He desires, and He
hardens whom He desires. 19 You will say to me then, “Why
does He still find fault? For who resists His will?” 20 On the
contrary, who are you, O man, who answers back to God? The

thing molded will not say to the molder, “Why did you make me like this,” will it? 21 Or does not the potter have a right over the clay, to make from the same lump one vessel for honorable use and another for common use? 22 What if God, although willing to demonstrate His wrath and to make His power known, endured with much patience vessels of wrath prepared for destruction? 23 And He did so to make known the riches of His glory upon vessels of mercy, which He prepared beforehand for glory,

Ephesians 1:4 just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. In love 5 He predestined us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will, 6 to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in the Beloved.

Matthew 22:14 For many are called, but few are chosen.

Mark 13:20 Unless the Lord had shortened those days, no life would have been saved; but for the sake of the elect, whom He chose, He shortened the days.

Acts 13:48 When the Gentiles heard this, they began rejoicing and glorifying the word of the Lord; and as many as had been appointed to eternal life believed. . . 16:14 the Lord opened her [Lydia’s] heart to respond to the things spoken by Paul.

Romans 8:28 And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose. 29 For those whom He foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many brethren; 30 and these whom He predestined, He also called; and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also

glorified.

Philippians 1:29 For to you it has been granted for Christ’s sake, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for His sake,

Colossians 3:12 So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.

1 Thessalonians 1:4 Knowing, brethren beloved by God, His choice of you.

2 Thessalonians 2:13 But we should always give thanks to God for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God has chosen you from the beginning for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth.

2 Timothy 1:9 Who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was granted us in Christ Jesus from all eternity.

2 Timothy 2:10 For this reason I endure all things for the sake of those who are chosen, so that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus and with it eternal glory.

Titus 1:1 Paul, a bond-servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ, for the faith of those chosen of God and the knowledge of the truth which is according to godliness.

James 1:18 In the exercise of His will He brought us forth by the word of truth, so that we would be a kind of first fruits among His creatures.

James 2:5 Listen, my beloved brethren: did not God choose the poor of this world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom which He promised to those who love Him?

1 Peter 2:9 But you are A CHOSEN RACE, A royal PRIESTHOOD, A HOLY NATION, A PEOPLE FOR God's OWN POSSESSION, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; 10 for you once were NOT A PEOPLE, but now you are THE PEOPLE OF GOD; you had NOT RECEIVED MERCY, but now you have RECEIVED MERCY.

Matthew 16:15 He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" 16 Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." 17 And Jesus said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Barjona, because flesh and blood did not reveal this to you, but My Father who is in heaven.

John 10:27 My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me; 28 and I give eternal life to them, and they will never perish; and no one will snatch them out of My hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand. 30 I and the Father are one."

John 17:24 Father, I desire that they also, whom You have given Me, be with Me where I am, so that they may see My glory which You have given Me, for You loved Me before the foundation of the world.

John 21:11 Simon Peter went up and drew the net to land, full of large fish, a hundred and fifty-three;

Acts 16:19 But when her masters saw that their hope of profit was gone, they seized Paul and Silas and dragged them into the market place before the authorities,

Acts 21:30 Then all the city was provoked, and the people rushed together, and taking hold of Paul they dragged him out of the temple, and immediately the doors were shut.

James 2:6 But you have dishonored the poor man. Is it not the rich who oppress you and personally drag you into court?

Philippians 1:6 For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.

John 17:4 I glorified You on the earth, having accomplished the work which You have given Me to do.

Revelation 21:6 Then He said to me, "It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give to the one who thirsts from the spring of the water of life without cost.

Ephesians 5:25 ... Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her, 26 so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, 27 that He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless.

Titus 2:14 who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.

Hebrews 12:14 pursue sanctification, without which no one will see the Lord.

Philippians 2:15 prove yourselves to be blameless and innocent 1 Peter 2:12 Keep your behavior excellent among the Gentiles, so that in the thing in which they slander you as evildoers, they may because of your good deeds, as they observe them, glorify God in the day of visitation.

2 Peter 3:14 Therefore, beloved, since you look for these things, be diligent to be found by Him in peace, spotless and blameless,
