How Covenant Children Are Saved Genesis 4:1-5

Introduction: "Be fruitful and multiply" begins. But we already know that there will be two kinds of seed. What will make the difference between them?

- 1. Covenant children can turn out to be "of the evil one" (cf. 1Jn 3:12), even if they are well trained, and even if it does not appear at first.
- 2. Half-heartedness toward the Lord can be an early warning sign.
- 3. The "seed of the woman" do more excellently not because their performance is worthy of God, but because their faith connects them to Christ, who is worthy (Heb 11:4).
- 4. Whole-heartedness toward the Lord is a fruit of this faith.
- 5. How we respond when corrected by God can expose to us whether we think that we owe God everything, or whether we think that God owes us everything.

Conclusion: Ultimately, the great difference-maker is whether we (a) realize our complete need of Christ, and (b) rejoice over God's provision of that need.
