Introduction

- I. Elijah, Ahab, the prophets of Baal (450), the prophets of the groves (400), and others of Israel were assembled on Mt. Carmel.
- II. Before the great contest begins, Elijah preaches a sermon.

The Prophet Standing for Jehovah (6) The Challenge

I. The Idea

- A. Elijah identifies the main sin of the people of Israel: halting between two opinions.
 - 1. They had tried to hold onto two truth claims and said there is room for both in Israel.
 - 2. This is a word the church desperately needs to hear today.
- B. Elijah launched a full frontal assault on this thinking with the challenge: "if Jehovah is the God, follow Him; but if Baal, then follow him." Elijah is showing what they are doing is untenable.

II. The Command

A. Through Elijah, God calls His church to reject Baal and not follow him because he is not god.

B. We are called to follow Him alone. We are called to trust and obey because He alone is God.

III. The Response

- A. The response of the people was silence: "and the people answered him not a word." Why?
- B. Let there be no silence here tonight in response to this word, but doing!
