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- So Remember: - Praying Is Showing! - Showing To The Lord: - A Heart Of: - True Praise & Thanksgiving! * Then - Second - We See That Praying Is: Serving! - Serving The Lord & His People! - Even As Paul Does In: - 1:9 - "For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers!" - Here - Paul Wants To Reassure The Romans: - That He Hasn't Forgotten About Them! - Instead - They Are Constantly: - On His Mind: - And - In His Prayers! - And - Even Though Many Miles Separate Them: - He Is Still **Serving** Them: - By *Praying* For Them! - Because Prayer Is: - A Secret Service: - Before The Lord! - IE: Of More Value & Power Than Even The Secret Service Detail That Protects The President! - Because - True Prayer Is Something: - Works Behind The Scenes! - It Is Often Hidden From The Ears & Eyes Of Others! - And - That Is The Way It **Should** Be! - In Matthew 6:6 - Jesus Taught Us: - "But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly!" - Paul Wants To Reassure The Romans: - Of His Personal & Secret Prayers For Them: - So - He Calls Upon God: - As His Witness! - "For God Is My Witness" - He Says! - The Original Order Is Even More Vivid: - "For My Witness Is God!" - No One Else: - May Ever Know Or See Or Hear: - You When You Pray! - But - Rest Assured: - God *Does* Know & See & Hear! - Because - To Him - It Is Also: - A Special Service! - For The Apostle Paul: - As Well As All Of The Other Apostles: - Prayer Was An Integral Part: - Of The Ministry Of The Gospel! - In 1:9 - Paul Adds - "Whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers!"
 - And This Is What Prayer Is!

- And Acts Of Devotion & Worship!

 - To The Lord!
- This Is One Reason Why:
 - When The First Deacons Of The Church Were Selected:
 - In Acts 6:4 The Apostles Said "But we will give ourselves continually to *prayer*, and to the ministry of the word!"
 - Prayer Was Put First:
 - Because It Is Not Merely A Supplement To Your Service!
 - IE: Like A Vitamin May Be A "Supplement" To Your Meals!
- No Praying Is Serving!
 - Service To The Lord!
 - But Also Service To Others!
 - You May Be Limited In Many Ways In Serving Others!
 - You May Have To Work:
 - Two Or More Jobs:
 - To Make Ends Meet!
 - You May Be A Young Mother:
 - With Your Hands Full:
 - All Throughout The Day!
 - You May Be Sick Or Weak:
 - And Unable To Serve With Your Hands:
 - The Way You Once Did!
 - But Prayer Is A Service:
 - That Any Christian Can Perform:
 - At Any Time!
- So This Morning See The Value Of Prayer!
 - Praying Is Serving!
 - And Pray For Each Other:
 - Even As Paul Did!
 - In A Thoughtful Way!
 - As Paul "Made Mention" Of Them To The Lord!
 - In A Timely Way!
 - As Paul Did "Without Ceasing" & "Always!"
 - And In A Tender Way!
 - As Paul Did "In Can Also Be Translated *Upon* My Prayers!"
 - IE: Like The Altar Of Incense That Was Before The Veil In The Tabernacle & The Temple Of God! It Was A Symbol Of The Prayers Of God's People Going Up With The Smoke Into Heaven Itself! As Revelation 8:4 Describes "And the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand!"
 - This Is What Paul Was Doing With Them:
 - In His Prayers! Offering Them Up:
 - In & With The Incense Of His Prayers:
 - Before The Lord!

Seeking! - In 1:11 - Paul Describes His Desire To See The Romans Even More: - "For I long to see you, that I may impart unto you some spiritual gift, to the end ye may be established!" - This Was The Foundation & The Main Reason: - For His Prayer! - And - They Were More About: - Them - Than - Him! - And - These Are The Kinds Of Prayers That Receive Positive Answers! - When Your Deepest Desires & Longings: - Are: - To See – Others! - "I Long To See You" - Paul Writes! - Even Though Praying Was Serving: - To Paul - There Was Still Something Special & Useful: - About Personal, Face-To-Face Ministry! - And So It Should Be: - For You & For Me! - Do You Have A "Longing" To See: - And To Be: - With God's People? - This Is A Purpose & A Prayer: - That Honors The Lord! - Even With A "Longing" Like "New-Borns Desiring" Their Milk! - You Need To Realize: - That There *Is* Something You Miss: - When You Aren't Together: - With God's People! - IE: Someone Once Said - "Absence Makes The Heart Grow Fonder?" Does It? Really? Or Does Absence Make The Heart Go "Further!" When It Comes To The Fellowship Of The Church, I Fear It's The Latter! - So - Your Prayers Should Also Be: - To Serve – Others! - Paul Sought To: - "Impart – Some Spiritual Gift!" - Even Though Paul Was: - A Very Spiritually-Gifted Man: - With Some Very Special & Specific Gifts! - The "Spiritual Gift" That He Describes Here: - Seems To Be Something: - A Bit More General - Like Just: - Being A Blessing To Them! - By Encouraging Them! - By Edifying Them! - This Too Is A Purpose & A Prayer: - That Honors The Lord! - Lord - Help Me Find A Way: - To Be A Blessing - "To Someone Today!" - William Sanday - "The Believer In Christ Should Himself Become A Center And Abounding Source Of Spiritual Influence And Blessing To Others!" - Is This The Longing Of Your Heart: - And The Longing In Your Prayers? - It Should Also Be:
 - So That Their Faith:Which So Many Had Already Heard So Much About:

- Whatever Gift Paul Wanted To "Impart" To Them:

- Was - "To The End Ye May Be Established!"

- To Strengthen – Others!

- Could Become Stronger!
- IE: And Living In Rome They Needed This More Than Most It Would Seem! Idolatrous Temples On Every Street! Temptations Around Every Corner! And On Top Of The Highest Hill The Man Who Would Become One Of The Most Ruthless Persecutors Of The Church Of Jesus Christ! They Needed To Be Established! And So Do We! So Does Our Church! So Does The Church In Our Community & Country & World!
- And All Of These Matters Are Purposes & Prayers:
 - That Honor The Lord!
 - If Only Our Deepest Longings:
 - Were Upward & Outward:
 - Instead Of Inward:
 - We Would See More Positive Answers To Our Prayers!
 - James 4:3 "Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts!"
 - But As The *Longing* Of Your Heart:
 - Reflects The Will Of The Lord:
 - What Does He Promise?
 - Matthew 7:7-8 "Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: / For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened!"
 - Remember Praying Is Seeking!
 - So Seek After What God Is After!
 - The Blessing Of His People!
- * Then Fifth We See That Praying Is:

 - Because Of What We Find In:
 - 1:12 Where Paul Adds That If & When:
 - He Makes It To Rome:
 - It Won't Be A One-Sided Fellowship!
 - No Instead He Writes:
 - "That is, that I may be comforted together with you by the mutual faith both of you and me!"
 - Personally, I Think That This "Comfort" Is:
 - The "Spiritual Gift" That Paul Mentioned In The Previous Verse!
 - But It Was A Gift:
 - That They Could Give:
 - As Well! Even To The Apostle Paul!
 - A Mutual Blessing & Encouragement & Comfort!
 - But Since Paul Is Still:
 - In This Verse Describing The Purpose:
 - For His Prayer:
 - To Visit Them & To See Them:
 - We Can Sense:

- Words Of Optimism!
 - It's As If Paul:
 - Is Already Anticipating:
 - God's Answer To His Prayer!
 - And Isn't This The Way You & I Should Pray As Well?
 - James 1:5-7 "If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him. / But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. / For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord!"
 - James Wrote This About Our Need For Wisdom!
 - But It Can Certainly Apply:
 - To Our Other Needs & Prayers As Well!
 - Do You Anticipate & Expect:
 - God To Answer Your Prayer?
 - **IE:** Remember The Famous Quote Of Missionary William Carey? The First Part Tells Us To "Expect Great Things From God" Before You Ever "Attempt Great Things For

God!" - This Is What It Can Be & Should Be Like: - In Your "Prayer Closet" As A Christian! - Expectation! Anticipation! - But - In 1:12 - We Also Read: - Words Of Opportunity! - Paul Needed The Comfort & Encouragement: - Of The Romans - At Least - Just As Much: - As The Romans Needed The Comfort & Encouragement: - Of The Apostle Paul! - This Is What Paul Was Looking Forward To: - And So - He Prayed To This End: - And For This Purpose! - And So Should You! - You See - To Be Together: - As Christians - Is A Gift: - That Does Our Spirits Good! - Psalm 133:1 - "Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!" - Often - From This Psalm: - We Emphasize The Word: "Unity!" - But - I Think We Also Need To Emphasize The Words: - "Dwell Together!" - Because - When You Don't: - "Dwell Together" - You Will Miss Out: - All Too Often: - On This Gift! - That Praying Is Satisfying: - When You Anticipate: - The Answers That Will Come: - From The Grace Of God! When It Comes To Praying: - There Really Is: - "More Than Meets The Eye" - Or: - Should I Say: - "More Then Meets The Ear!" - IE: How Many Times Have You Heard People Mock - After A Tragedy Of Some Kind - Those Who Say - "Our Thoughts & Prayers Are With You!" Now - For Some - That Statement May Be Nothing More Than That! - But - For Those Who Can & Do Approach God In Prayer: - As Paul Did - As "My God" - And - "Through Jesus Christ" - There Is More Than Meets The Ear: - In Your Prayer!
