#### INTRODUCTION

Today we will be consider how Jesus as the Father's Son is Sustained, Exalted and Honored.

#### HOW THEN ARE WE GOING TO CONSIDER THIS TEXT?

- vv.1-4 God points to His Servant Son.
- vv.5-10 (Psalm 40) God Sustained His Servant Son.
- vv.11-14 God Exalts His Servant Son.
- vv.15-18 God Honors His Servant Son.

# I. vv.1-4 God points to His Servant Son

<u>Isa.11:1</u> "And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots:"

<u>Jer.23:5</u> "Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth."

Zech.6:12 "...Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, saying, Behold the man whose name is The BRANCH; ...shall grow up out of his place, and he shall build the temple of the LORD:"

## **LIST OF MODERN SHADOWS to beware of**

- Church buildings, institutions, earthly power and status (my kingdom is not of this world Jhn 18:36)
- Covenant identification outward classification of membership in the Covenant Community of the Church is not the substance.
- Baptism and the Lord's Supper They are not the substance, they powerfully point us to the substance.

### II. vv.5-10 (Psalm 40) God Sustained His Servant Son.

<u>Psalms 40:6-8</u> Sacrifice and offering thou didst not desire; mine ears (body) hast thou opened: burnt offering and sin offering hast thou not required. Then said I, Lo, I come: in the volume of the book it is written of me, I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy law is within my heart.

<u>Isa. 1:11</u> "what purpose is the multitude of your sacrifices unto me? saith the LORD: I am full of the burnt offerings of rams, and the fat of fed beasts; and I delight not in the blood of bullocks, or of lambs, or of he goats."

<u>Amos 5:21-22</u> "I hate, I despise your feast days, and I will not smell in your solemn assemblies. Though ye offer me burnt offerings and your meat offerings, I will not accept them: neither will I regard the peace offerings of your fat beasts"

<u>Jer.6:20</u> "To what purpose cometh there to me incense from Sheba, and the sweet cane from a far country? your burnt offerings are not acceptable, nor your sacrifices sweet unto me."

#### III. vv.11-14 God Exalts His Servant Son.

➤ **Ps.110:1** is made possible by **FIRST** – The Person and Work of Jesus and **SECONDLY** – By the subduing of rebellious hearts, thus turning enemies to humble servants.
