But His protection and care is evident. Many Jews did not return to Israel from Persia, and this book shows how God cared for them. Takes place during time of Xerxes (called by the Hebrew name <i>Ahasuerus</i>) of Persia, who reigned from 486-464 BC.</p> <p>Esther, like CHRIST, offers herself to die for God's people. INTRO , NEHEMIAH

Nehemiah (*Nehemyah*, “comfort of Yahweh”)leads third return to Jerusalem. Builds wall in 52 days, attempts to revive and reform people of God (which takes considerably longer).

Artaxerxes’(reigned 464-423) cupbearer. Jerusalem’s governor, 444-432 BC. Esther is step-mother of Artaxerxes, may have gotten position for him. Visits Jerusalem 444 BC, leaves 432, back to Jerusalem, perhaps 425.

Evils encountered by Nehemiah are addressed by Malachi, contemporary prophet.

CHRIST: The restorer. Gives up high position to bless people of God. Book records (2:1-8) the announcement that signals the beginning of 70 years until Messiah(Daniel 9:25-27).
