Robert Murray M'Cheyne Daily reading Plan

Born on Friday 21 May 1813,

He died at the young age on the 25th March 1843 where he caught typhus fever while doing his pastoral outreach work.

Son of Adam McCheyne,

Robert was educated at Edinburgh University.

In 1835, he became Assistant at Lambert (near Stirling).

In 1836, he was ordained Minister of St. Peter's Established Church in Dundee.

- The people of Dundee were a poor and needy people.
- The peoples need for the Lord was in great need, with open sin a way of life.
- Robert had a deep burden for the people of Dundee, that his outreach work was daily where he was constantly meeting and witnessing to people.

In 1839, he went to Israel as one of the Mission of Enquiry to the Jews from the Church of Scotland.).

CWI Christian witness to Israel changing name to International Mission to Jewish People.

Robert's Christian life for us to mirror.

• His life was devoted to personal holiness 1 Peter 1:15-16 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; 16

Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy. Robert time was greatly in the presence of the Lord, through reading the Bible and prayer. As Robert quoted "What a man is on his knees before God, that he is, and nothing more."

Just like Robert we need to be spiritually disciplined ready to witness.
We should not let the Devil allow you to bring you down with past sins.
Instead, we should allow the lord work in us, through the Holy Ghost, to cleanse us from sin and make us holy. As Robert quoted "If nothing else will do to sever me from my sins, Lord, send me such sore and trying calamities as shall awake me from earthly slumbers. It must always be best to be alive to Thee, whatever be the guickening instrument."

Robert M'Cheyne daily reading plan is a great tool for your daily reading, giving you a mixture of 4 different Bible books reading 1 chapter of them.

This is a great plan to do on your own, as a couple or as family devotion.
