
## **THE CANTICLE OF THE SUN**

**<sup>8</sup> lightning and hail, snow and cloud, stormy wind that executes his command,**





alleluia***

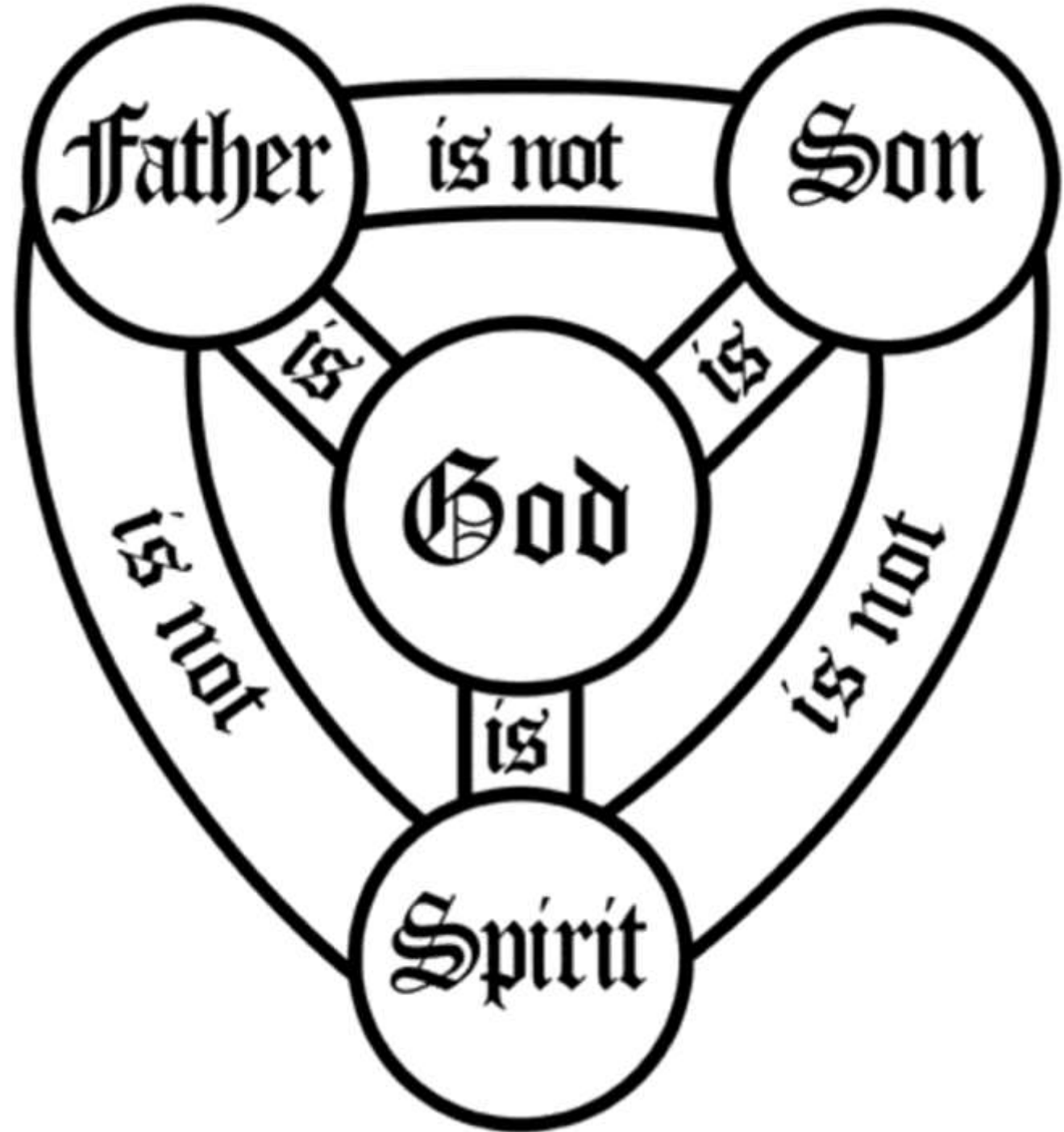




