"My Hope Is Built!" Lamentations 3:21 1. Welcome To The First Sunday Of The New Year! - It Is Always Good To Start The Year Off Right: - Worshiping The Lord: - Together As A Church! - As We Have Done For The Last Several Years: - I Would Like To Share: - What Will Be Our Special Focus For The Year To Come! Last Year - Our Primary Focus Was On One Of The Great Doctrines: 2. - And Attributes Of God: - His Immutability! - Which Simply Means That: - God Never Changes! - Even Though Last Year Brought Many Different Kinds: - Of Challenges & Changes To Our Lives: - As Individuals, As Families, And As A Church: - God Himself Has Not Changed: - Throughout Them All! - Neither In His Person: - Nor In His Purposes! - Even As The Lord Himself Put It: - In Malachi 3:6 - "For I am the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed!" And So - To Remind Us Of This Truth Last Year: 3. - On Sunday Mornings: - Our Primary Focus Was On: - The Immutable & Unchanging Gospel Of God's Grace: - As Revealed To Us In Paul's Letter Of Galatians! - And I Pray That Our Exploration Of That Book: - Has Increased Your Faith In: - And Love For The True Gospel - And Especially The One Who The Gospel Is All About - The Lord Jesus Christ! - Who Remains - "The Same Yesterday, To Day, And For Ever!" (Hebrews 13:8) - And On Sunday Evenings: - Our Primary Focus Was On: - The Doctrine Of God's Immutability! - As The Puritan, Thomas Watson, Once Described It - "There Are Changes In Everything, But In God!" - It Is The Unchanging Nature Of God: - That We Need To "Set Our Sights" On: - In This Ever-Changing World! - IE: Even As Sailors Would Use A Sextant In Order To Stay On Their Proper Course - "Shooting A Star" That, From Their Perspective At Least, Never Changes! - I Pray That You Have Also Grown In Your Pursuit: - Of Your Immutable & Unchanging God! - Keep "Looking Unto - And Setting Your Sights On - Jesus [As] The Author And Finisher Of [Your] Faith!" (Hebrews 12:2) For This New Year: 4. - We Will Begin With Our Focus On: - Biblical & Christian Hope! - This Is Not The Kind Of Hope: - That The World Wishes For & Tries To Offer! - But The Kind Of Hope: - That We Find In The Word Of God & Offered To All Those Who Believe In The Lord Jesus Christ!

- It Is The Kind Of Hope That We Find:

- Possessed By Jeremiah The Prophet:

- Known As The "Weeping Prophet" Because:

- Of The Discouragement & Distress He So Often Faced:

- In A World & Society That Had Forgotten God!

. Let's First Look Together At Jeremiah's Distress:

- In Lamentations 3:1-20!

- Perhaps You Have Felt This Way:

- At Some Point In Your Life!

- Perhaps You Feel This Way Today:

- Even Wondering If This New Year Will Bring Anything Positive With It!

- Well - We Must Not Stop With:

- Jeremiah's Lament In 3:20!

- Because Then We Find That In The Lord:

- There Really Is Hope!

- Lamentations 3:21-26 - "This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope. / 22 It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. / 23 They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness. / 24 The LORD is my portion, saith my soul; therefore will I hope in him. / 25 The LORD is good unto them that wait for him, to the soul that seeketh him. / 26 It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the LORD!"

- In These Six Verses:

- We Find The Word "Hope" Three Times!

- And All Three Times - The Basis For Jeremiah's Hope Is The Lord Himself!

So - This Morning - I Would Like For Us To Consider Together:

- What Is This *Hope*:

- That We Find In The Bible?

- This *Hope* That Was Like A Spiritual Ointment That Brought Encouragement To Such A Discouraged Soul Like Jeremiah!

- This Hope:

- That Is The Possession:

- Of Every True Child Of God!

- Every True Believer In Jesus Christ!

- What Is Hope & Where Can Hope Be Found?

* First - To Answer These Questions - Look At:

1. The Need For Hope!

- Because There Is A Great Need For Hope!

- Because Hopelessness Is Seen Everywhere In The World!

- You Can Go Far Away:

- Where Food Is Scarce & The Future Is Bleak! **IE:** Think About The Situation Of Those Civilians Who Were In The Syrian City Of Aleppo! Many Were Caught In The Middle Of A Conflict, And Were Brutalized From Both Sides!

- Hopelessness!

- Or You Can Stay Close To Home:

- Where People Are Still Struggling! With Their Finances - Because Of The Increasing Costs Of Living! With Their Families & Even Their Future!

- Hopelessness Is Common!

- People Look To Many Things To Offer Them Some Hope:

- Sports Teams! Maybe Not For Colts / Broncos Fans This Year! So - Maybe This Is A Bad Example! But A Good Example Is That Of:

- Politics! With The Results Of The Elections - Many Hope For Change!

- Change Of Circumstances!

- But It Is A Hope That Does Not Last! Temporary!

- There Is A Great Need For Lasting Hope!

Because:

- There Are Those Who Are Lacking Hope!

- The Bible Clearly Teaches That Anyone Who Is Not A Part Of The Family Of God Has No True Hope!

- Ephesians 2:12 - "That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel,

and strangers from the covenants of promise, *having no hope*, and without God in the world!"

- They Need A Real & Lasting Hope!

- There Are Those Who Have Lost Hope!

- Once, The Light Of Hope Shone Brightly, But That Light & Hope Has Faded Into The Darkness All Around!

- Like The "Whole House Of Israel" In Ezekiel 37:11 - "Our bones are dried, and our hope is lost!"

- They Need A Real & Lasting Hope!

- There Are Those Who Have Limited Hope!

- That May Last For A Little While, But Not As Long As They Need It – A False Hope!

- Paul Recognized The Importance Of An Eternal Hope For Christians When He Said: "If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable!" (1 Corinthians 15:19)

- They Need A Real & Lasting Hope!

- Which Are You Like?

- Are You Lacking Hope?

- Have You Lost Hope?

- Or Do You Have A Limited Hope?

- There Is A Great Need For True Hope – For All Of Us!

* But We Also Need To Understand:

2. The Meaning Of Hope!

- The Hope That We All Need:

- Is Drastically Different Than:

- The Hope That We Are Often Offered:

- By This World!

- You See:

- Our Use Of Hope:

- Involves Desire:

- And Uncertainty!

- Many Times, When We Use The Word Hope:

- It Means Little More To Us Than:

- A Wish!

- Wanting & Hoping For Something Better - That May Or May Not Ever Happen!

nappen!

- This Is The Kind Of "Hope" That People Talk About:

- When It Is A New Year!

- Hoping For A Better Time:

- And For Better Things!

- One Writer Defines This Kind Of Hope In This Way:

- "To Wish For, To Expect, But Without Certainty Of The Fulfilment - To Desire Very Much, But

With No Real Assurance Of Getting Your Desire!" (J. Hampton Keathley, III - Bible.org)

- This Is The Kind Of "Hope" The World Has & This Is The Only Kind Of "Hope That

The World Can Offer – With No Guarantee! – But This Is Also The Kind Of "Hope"

That We All Too Often Have As Well!

- But This Is Altogether Different Than:

- God's Use Of Hope!

- Which Involves Desire:

- And Certainty!

- This Is The Big Difference:

- Between The World's Hope & God's Hope – The Kind Of Hope We Find In The Bible!

- The Words Used In The Bible:

- That Are Frequently Translated "Hope" In Our English Bibles:

- Both In The Old Testament & In The New Testament:

- Refer To Something That Is *Expected*!

- The Same Writer Defines This Biblical Kind Of Hope In This Way:

- "Hope [In The Bible] Is An Indication Of Certainty! A Strong And Confident Expectation!"

- See This All Throughout The Bible!

- And So - Back In Lamentations 3:21:

- Where The Prophet Jeremiah Wrote:

- "This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope!"
- He Was Not Talking About:
 - A Hope & A Wish In Something:
 - That God *Might* Give To Him! No!
- He Was Talking About:
 - A Hope & An Assurance In:
 - The Mercy & The Compassion & The Faithfulness Of God:
 - That Were Guaranteed To Him, As A Child Of God!
- Do You Have *This* Kind Of Hope?
 - If You Are A Child Of God This Morning:
 - Like Jeremiah Through Faith In:
 - The Lord Jesus Christ!
 - Then You Do!
 - It Is Not Based On Potential:
 - But On Promises!
 - The Promises Of Almighty God!
 - This Kind Of Hope Is Your Hope!
 - Because Of:

3. The Source Of Hope!

- King David Experienced The Same Kind Of:
 - Discouragement & Despair In His Life:
 - At Times As Well!
 - And He Captured His Feelings:
 - As Well As The Solution He FoundL
 - In Several Of His Psalms!
 - Including Psalm 42:1-5:

- "As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after thee, O God. / 2 My soul thirsteth for God, for the living God: when shall I come and appear before God? / 3 My tears have been my meat day and night, while they continually say unto me, Where is thy God? / 4 When I remember these things, I pour out my soul in me: for I had gone with the multitude, I went with them to the house of God, with the voice of joy and praise, with a multitude that kept holyday. / 5 Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted in me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him for the help of his countenance!"

- And Later In 42:11 He Repeats Both The Object:
 - And The Source Of His Hope "Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God!"
- The Source Of True Hope:
 - Is The One True God!
 - And He Is The Sole Source:
 - Of The Hope We Need!
 - And You Will Only Experience Personal Hope From The Person Of Hope:
 - If & When Your Focus Is On Him!
 - Like Jeremiah! Like David!
 - So When It Seems That All "Hope" Is Lost:
- You Need To Keep Thinking On The Lord!
 - Remember The Words Of Jeremiah?
 - In Lamentations 3:21 -"This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope!"
 - Like The Hymn "I Think Of My Blessed Redeemer, I Think Of Him All The Day Long!"
 - When You Think On The Lord:
 - You Will Find Your Hope:
 - Because He Is The Source Of Hope!
- You Need To Keep Trusting In The Lord!
 - In Many Ways:
 - "Hope" & "Trust" Are Synonymous:
 - In The Bible!

- See This In:

- Psalm 71:5 - "For thou art my *hope*, O Lord GOD: thou art my *trust* from my youth!"

- So - When You Trust In The Lord:

- You Will Find Your Hope In The Lord:
 - Because He Is The Source Of Hope!
- You Need To Keep Turning To The Lord!
 - Lamentations 3:26:
 - "It is good that a man should both *hope* and quietly wait for the salvation of the LORD!"

- The Lord Is The Only Source:

- For The Hope & Assurance That:
 - We Need!

Conclusion:

1. So - To Help Us This Year:

- Grow In Our Hope:
 - Both *In* The Lord & *From* The Lord:
 - We Are Going To Focus Our Attention On:
 - The Hope That God Offers Through His Word!
- 2. Beginning Next Sunday Morning:
 - We Are Going To Begin A Series Of Messages:
 - Through The Old Testament Book Of:
 - Esther!
 - Esther Is Such A Unique Book:
 - Because Nowhere In The Book:
 - Is The Name Of God Mentioned!
 - And Because The People Of God:
 - Are In A Foreign Country Living In A Foreign Culture:
 - It Seems As If God Is Completely Absent:
 - Along With Any Hope!
 - In Many Ways It Is A Parallel To Our Own Time & Place:
 - Because Every Christian No Matter Where Or When We Live:
 - Are Living As "Strangers & Pilgrims On The Earth!" (Hebrews 11:13)
 - And Sometimes It Even Feels To Us:
 - That God Is Completely Absent:
 - As Well As Any Hope!
 - But What We Will Find:
 - All Throughout Esther And In Our Own Lives:
 - Is That As Paul Puts It In Romans 15:4 "Whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have *hope!*"
 - Even If God's Name Is Not Mentioned!
 - Even When God's Presence Seems Absent!
 - God Is Still There And So Is His Hope!
- 3. But Also On Sunday Nights:
 - We Are Going To Explore More Closely The Hope:
 - That God Offers To His People:
 - Through Jesus Christ!
 - Even As We Read In:
 - Titus 2:13 "Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ!"
- 4. And So My Prayer Is That:
 - Through His Word This Year:
 - God Will Build Up Our Confident Hope In Him:
 - And In The Lord Jesus Christ:
 - More And More:
 - As We Await The Arrival Of Our "Blessed Hope!"
- 5. And What Will This Biblical Kind Of Hope Do?
 - When You Are Weary!

- His Hope Will Give You Rest!

- Psalm 16:9 - "Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoiceth: my flesh also shall *rest in hope!*"

- When You Are Weak!
 - His Hope Will Give You Strength!

- Psalm 31:24 - "Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that *hope* in the LORD!"

- When You Are Worried!

- His Hope Will Give You Peace!

- Psalm 42:5 - "Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted in me? *hope thou in God!*"

- When You Are Weeping!

- His Hope Will Give You Joy!
 - Psalm 146:5 "Happy is he that hath the God of Jacob for his help, whose *hope* is in the LORD his God!"
- When You Trust In The Lord Jesus Christ:
 - You Will Have This Kind Of Hope!

* "My Hope Is Built On Nothing Less!"

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
