Sermon Outline for Sunday, January 3, 2021
Sermon: “**Stay Home and Weep, January 6, 2021.**”

I Text:

Old Covenant: *Ezekiel 36:22-32*

New Covenant: *Luke 19:41-44*

II Doctrine:

Christians are not permitted to throw themselves behind every political cause. We must be “wise as serpents and innocent as doves.” Our loyalty is to King Jesus and his law for the Nations. We will not protest at the Nation’s capital at the behest of a politician. I advise all Christian women and children especially, to stay home. Let us weep as Jesus did, for all the spiritually dead people who will be in the streets that day. Wait and prepare for the real civil war.

God’s people should be preparing themselves to stand up for the faith. The Church should be weeping for it’s denial of Jesus Christ in the public square. We didn’t storm the capital over a central bank, abortion, and same sex marriage. Let us repent and weep like Peter for our denial, and advocate for Christ’s commandments in this nation.

The United States must not repeat the mistake of Israel in the Old Testament. We cannot reject Jesus Christ as King, and place our faith in a corrupt Church fornicating with a corrupt state. Bible believing Christians should be forming our own “nation within a nation”, to defend ourselves against a united whore church and state.
