## **Grumbling at God's Provision**

#### 1 Corinthians 10:10 (ESV)

nor grumble, as some of them did and were destroyed by the Destroyer.

- "Grumble" is gonguzo\_ (onomatopoec)
- This is a serious sin, not simply temporary unhappiness due to discomfort
- There are various references to cases of grumbling in OT (Ps. 96:14-39; Ex. 16:2; Ex. 17:3; Num. 11:1; Num. 14:2; Deut. 1:27; et. al.)

### 1 Corinthians 10:12 (ESV)

Therefore let anyone who thinks that he stands take heed lest he fall.

- This is a direct application from Paul
- The arrogant "knowers" in Corinth are sure they stand and harm others in the church
- False confidence in special knowledge and spiritual experiences was a set up to fail
- 'Thinks' dokeo\_ can also imply 'seems'
- 'Stands' is histe\_mi (1 Cor. 15:1)

- Escape is not a secret way, but relational
- Faithful God keeps covenant (Deut. 7:9)
