- The Only Information that is Given Are the Qualifications for the Office
- Acts 6 is Not Referring to Deacons

- Deacons Who Are Men
 - -Reverent
 - Not double-tongued
 - -Not given to much wine
 - Not greedy for money
 - Holding the mystery of the faith with a pure conscience

The Qualifications of Deacons

- -Blameless
- -Husband of one wife
- -Ruling their children and houses well

- Deacons Who Are Women
 - -Reverent
 - -Not slanderers
 - -Temperate
 - -Faithful in all things
