# Proverbs for Parenting 5. The Wisdom of Discipline

#### I. The Loving Activity

- 3. This chastening is needed because there is still so much sin in us.

- 2. Others would despise the chastening of the Lord by responding to it as too heavy.

- 2. This is what we must teach our children.
