- III. In The Result we see in the Supper what Christ works in us: spiritual nourishment.
 - A. Christ blesses His people through the means of partaking of the Lord's Supper.
 - B. Partaking of the Lord's Supper is a great delight by faith and through the working of the Holy Spirit.
