

### **38:39-40**

**“Can you hunt the prey for the lion, Or satisfy the appetite of the young lions,** One reading of Psalm 104 will help us see that this Psalmist was a great student of Job (such as Psalm 104:21). Moreover, a glance of Job 9 will help us see that Job understood a lot of what God is proposing. Job 9:13, for example, is a foreshadow of verse 40.

Incidentally, when it comes to the lions of Isaiah 5:29 or Joel 1 or Hosea 13:7-9, we see that God sends “lions” against the disobedient, and He is the One feeding them. **40 When they crouch in their dens, Or lurk in their lairs to lie in wait?** Now, consider Christ clawing His way to Calvary, being torn on Calvary, and ripping apart His enemies...and you will have considered the Lion of the Tribe of Judah (Revelation 5:5). Isaiah 62:1 we’ll see that it is the Father Who feeds His Lion.
