ACTS 21-24

Scripture Reading

- Paul heads to Jerusalem and arrives there.
- Paul is mobbed and arrested at the Temple.
- Paul twice defends himself before Lysias and the Jewish people in Jerusalem.
- Paul defends himself before Felix in Caesarea.

Luke's Four Emphases in Acts 21–24

- 1. Face your suffering like Jesus (and Paul). Paul was determined to go to Jerusalem.
- 2. Pursue Christian unity by sacrificing your freedoms. *Paul submitted to Jewish Ritual.*
- 3. People don't need religion. They need to submit to King Jesus. *The Jews Rejected Paul.*
- 4. Christian, you should be a good citizen. *Paul was invocent.*

LUKE'S MAIN POINT

Nothing can stop the advance of the gospel because it's *the Lord's will* (Acts 21:14).
