Acts 26:19-21 "Whereupon, O king Agrippa, I was not disobedient unto the heavenly vision: $\frac{20}{20}$ But showed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and *then* to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance. $\frac{21}{21}$ For these causes the Jews caught me in the temple, and went about to kill *me*."
