The Faithless Church

Hebrews 10:26-31

Introductory Statement: Hebrews 10 must be received as a genuine warning for all believers.

Context: In this application section of the epistle, the author contrasts Christians living by faith (v. 19-25) with those forsaking assembly (v. 25) and in danger of apostasy (v. 26-31).

Apostasy

Who are those in danger of apostasy? (v. 26, 29)

What is apostasy? (1Ti 1:19, Heb 3:12, 6:4-6, 2Pt 2:20)

Examples of apostasy in Scripture

(Jn 6:66, 1Jn 2:19, 2Ti 1:15, 2Ti 4:10)

The unpardonable sin (Mt 12:31-32)

A deliberate and final abandonment of the faith (2Pt 2:21)

Is it possible for you to repent?

What if I do not repent?

A fearful expectation of judgment (v. 27)

Who are these people under judgement? (v. 28-29)

Will God judge "His people?" (Apostasy vs. Perseverance)

In what sense are these people sanctified?

Does this apply to us?

The terrible fear of the judgment of God (30-31)
