God is Sovereign and Powerful | Acts 4:23-31


Context: Peter and John have healed a crippled beggar, preached, been arrested, and warned not to speak to anyone in Jesus' name—and this passage shows what they did next.

How should church respond when facing opposition?

How God's sovereignty and power shape our prayers:

1. Because God is sovereign, we (24-28).

2. Because God is powerful, we ask him to (29-31).
