B. A BAD ENDING (chps.13,14)

A. CONFESS THAT JESUS IS LORD! (9:16,17; 13:13,14; Dt.17:14-20; see 1Chr.16:31; Ps.93:1; 96:10; 97:1; 99:1; Dan.4:17,25,32f; Eph.1:19-23; Rev.11:15; 12:10; etc.!; contra 1Sam.13:11f; 15:8f,13; Judg.17:6; 21:25; Prov.12:15)

B. OBEDIENCE IS SIMPLY DOING WHAT YOU'RE TOLD! (10:8; 13:8f; 13,14; see Lk.1:38; Jn.8:29; see Acts 4:19; 17:11)

C. DISOBEDIENCE IS NEVER NECESSARY OR PRACTICAL! (13:11,8f; 15:15,20f; see Judg.17:6; 21:25; Prov.12:15; see Gen.3:6/2:17)

D. DISOBEDIENCE FORFEITS PRESENT & FUTURE BLESSINGS! (13:13,14; 15:28; 16:14; also 2Sam.12:8,10f; see Dt.30:1f; c.27-29; Lk.6:20-26; Saul, David also; Dt.30:1f,etc.!)

E. DISOBEDIENCE BEGETS MORE FOOLISHNESS! (13:13; 14:24f,30f,39f; 15:9,15f; see 2Sam.12:9)

F. THE WORD OF GOD: USE OR LOSE! (1Sam.10:8; 13:8f; see 13:15f; 28:6; Amos 8:11; Heb.3:5f(Ps95:7f))

G. PERSEVERE TO THE END! (13:8f,10; see Mt.10:22; 24:13; Ps.27:14; 37:7,9; 130:5; Is.40:30; Mt.25:1f; Lk.20:9f; Phil.3:20; 1Th.1:10; Jms.5:7; 2Pt.3:1ff; Ps.73:1f)
