F. B. Meyer (1847-1929): Popular evangelical. Baptist pastor in England:

F.B. Meyer, *Present Truth* (Sept. 7, 1911):

"I have known several families that have been cursed by having recourse to clairvoyants and mediums. There are grave dangers in these things; and **when occult powers are used for selfish ends**, it is possible for men and women to be filled with evil spirits."

F.B. Meyer, *The Modern Craze of Spiritualism* (1919):

"...its modern phase, dates from the year 1848..."

"Musical instruments are played without human agency."

"Messages are given, purporting to come from the departed."

"Apparently the Almighty has locked and bolted our human nature against the intrusion of the demon - world , and it is at our peril that we open the door from within or allow it to be broken in from without."

"A man of high repute told me recently that a lady had come to him complaining that her life was made a perfect torment by the suggestion of unclean spirits , of

which she could not rid herself . She had been an **habituée of** [habitual attendee of **séances** and now was held by a kind of obsession. He entreated her to promise to tear herself from their fatal spell, and she promised to go to but one more, on the following day. But that day she became raving mad, **rushed in an almost nude condition into the public** thoroughfare, and has been for the last two years in an asylum."

"An outburst of Spiritualism has preceded the close of every great era of human history."

Some short time ago the author lost his wife, and with her the light of his life. But being fortunate enough to number some good psychics among his personal friends, he was brought into living relations with his departed wife, and for him the bitterness of death ceased...**This book has forewords by Mr. Meyer... 'We are evidently passing into a new realm, the veil is getting thinner' ...**"

"MINISTRY OF THE UNSEEN. We have before us advance proofs of a book shortly to be issued under the title 'The Ministry of the Unseen,' by L. V. H. Witley...It is 'a personal experience of, and testimony to, Love from beyond the veil.' The writer, whose wife passed from a convalescent home to spirit life in

March, 1909, after a long and trying illness, has received messages written by his own hand which he is firmly convinced are due to thought impressions from her, which are poured through him - an instance, he believes, **of telepathic co-operation 'between one still living on earth and another long since deceased,' as Mr. Myers puts it...**Eighteen months after her passing he was assured from the other side, by one who had been in contact with her, that his wife wished to write to him, and that these messages were to be passed on to others. He was greatly surprised, but now rejoices in the fulfilment of the assurance. He says: 'I simply sit alone in my wife's realised presence and write down that which she impresses upon me...'

He writes: 'To forlorn and grief-stricken and lonely souls I would say: What is possible for me is possible for you...All you need is a brave and confident and receptive heart, and those who have been seemingly so far from you shall in some way or other make their real presence known to you as a happy experience.'

D.M. Panton, *The End of the Age*:

"How will this present evil Age end? 'Not by the crash of revolution,' says Mr. F.B. Meyer, **'but by the spiral staircase of evolution, shall the world pass to perfect order and beauty'...**"

In Panton's article, *Seducing Spirits*, he wrote:

"...Christian leaders, at this moment and before our eyes, are giving ever deeper and closer heed to spirits...advancing the most monstrous claims...these seductive spirits masquerade as the Dead. 'I pray **to my wife**,' said Dr. Joseph Parker [another popular English preacher in 19th century], 'every day. I never come to the work without asking her to come with me: and she does come. I never come to this place without her coming with me' (Review of Reviews, Jan. 1902). **In a book of messages from the dead, endorsed by prefaces from Mr. R. J. Campbell and Dr. F. B. Meyer, Mr. Meyer says:** 'We are evidently passing into a new realm. The veil is getting thinner, and the day is at hand when we shall see face to face. What may lie immediately before us is known only in Heaven: but it is sweet to think that the Departed may not only be a great cloud of witnesses, but **agreat**

body of helpers!' This is Spiritualism...that is, Necromancy...On Mr. Meyer's words Mr. W. T. Stead comments thus: "The work is important because...When so competent an authority [as Meyer] tells us that he is convinced that the spirits of our departed friends may return and visit us, is it not the duty of all Christians to take up the study of Spirit Return and Ministry as a religious duty?"

"DEAR SIR, Will you allow me to point out that both Mr. Drew and yourself unwittingly doubtless, have done me an injustice in suggesting that Dr. Meyer **disclaims** any sympathy with the spiritualistic tendencies of "The Ministry of the Unseen?" [his book]."

Light, 1913:

LIFE WITHIN AND WITHOUT THE VEIL. By L. V. H. WITLEY:

"The Rev. Dr. A. C. Dixon, late of Chicago, who now occupies the pulpit of the Metropolitan Tabernacle, so long filled by the late C. H. Spurgeon, has made himself more or less notorious as an exponent and defender of theological beliefs which **have been abandoned by many Evangelical thinkers...**"

"The Convention at Keswick is an annual gathering, of members of most of the Christian denominations of this country...Amongst the more prominent speakers at this Convention, **the Rev. Dr. F. B. Meyer has for many years taken an honoured place**, but I happen to know that, **on account of the foreword which he contributed to my first work, The Ministry of the Unseen, Dr. Meyer has been debarred from occupying his customary place upon the platform...**

There are points in connection with Spiritualism with which Dr. Meyer has little or no sympathy, but...he has at least an open mind with reference to scientific, psychological, and psychical truth.

...Here is the passage from Dr. Dixon's address...'Satan comes to us right at our weakest time, when we are stupefied by grief sometimes, and we want to speak another word and get another vision...'

But it is time...I quote a passage or two from a booklet by **Dr. Meyer, entitled 'Our Blessed Dead':**

"Let us know that they who have left us love us still; that their thoughts still enfold us in tender embracements, and follow us in our wanderings, and hover over us like ministering angels. Press this thought to your innermost soul - that those you have 'loved long since and lost awhile' love you still, care for you still...The blessed dead are not far away. Heaven is near at hand. To the holy soul, not heaven only, but earth, and vale, and hill, and all lovely scenes, are thronged with the presence of bright, radiant, and holy spirits."

Nor is this all. In a book issued not long since, **Dr. Meyer says farther:**

"The veil that screens the unseen world glows with unusual radiance, waxes thin, and sways to and fro with movements on the other side."

One other quotation must not be omitted...I take this paragraph from a letter **addressed by Dr. Meyer to the editor** of 'The British Weekly' :

'It seems to me that almost unconsciously the Christian thought of our time is drifting towards the spiritual and the eternal...the growth of Christian Science, of Theosophical teaching, of Spiritualism, of Occultism of various kinds, may be quoted as evidence of the trend of this Divine movement. The great human child is awakening in the growing radiance of a new dawn...!...

...This is indeed a huge advance upon the attitude of those who designate Spiritualism as 'the doctrines of demons'...And so, to paraphrase Galileo, we may say, 'Thank God, the world does move, after all!'...
