John Piper- Let the nations be glad

"Missions is not the ultimate goal of the church. Worship is. Missions exists because worship doesn't. Worship is ultimate, not missions, because God is ultimate, not man. When this age is over, and the countless millions of the redeemed fall on their faces before the throne of God, missions will be no more. It is a temporary necessity. But worship abides forever."

The call to go out and to preach

God's call to make His way known on earth (vs 1-2)

Psalm 67:1-2

"God be merciful to us and bless us, and cause His face to shine upon us, Selah... That Your way may be known on earth, your salvation among all nations."

The Aaronic blessing- Num 6:24-26

"The LORD bless you and keep you; The LORD make His face shine upon you, And be gracious to you; The LORD lift up His countenance upon you, And give you peace."

Psalm 67:2

"...That Your way may be known on earth, your salvation among all nations."
