Please read the passage and interact with the following questions:

1. Why is Paul's question in v. 1 a good sign of a right understanding of the gospel?
2. How does Paul answer his own question and why?
3. How did it happen that we became "dead to sin"? What are some of the implications of this reality?
4. How is our baptism a picture of the reality of our being united with Christ in His death and resurrection?
5. What difference does the reality of v. 7 (for he who has died is freed from sin) make in your daily life?
6. Paul commands us to "consider ourselves to be dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus." How can we actually obey this command this week?
7. Let's take some time and thank God for the joy of our union with Christ that has truly and actually freed us from sin and delivered into a new eternal life.
