	distance David from the throne, which only endears
	him to the people he will one day lead, putting him in
	direct contact with them (18:12-16).
IV.	Saul devises a plan to place David in
	way in the extreme, baiting David into the ruse through
	marriage that only endears David to the royal family
	(18:17-22).

V. Saul coordinates his ruse through his servants	to require
100 Philistine foreskins, a task that would	surely fail
and cost David his life—David collects	 ;
adding to his legendary reputation (18:23-2	27).
