- 1. Role Models, Fans, and Followers
 - A. "Walk in the same way" Good role models are worthy of imitation.
 - B. Jesus, worthy of imitation, is not merely a role model.
 - C. The occasion for John's letter: The necessity of obedience
 - D. To walk as Jesus we must walk with Jesus.
- 2. Jesus, our Advocate (v1)
 - A. Comfort during times of struggle
 - B. Our Defender is the Righteous One.
- 3. Jesus, our Propitiation (v2)
 - A. Jesus Christ is our salvation.
 - B. The wrath of God has been satisfied.
 - C. His sacrifice is applicable to *all* who trust in him.
- 4. Jesus, our Example (3-6)
 - A. The more we observe Jesus, the more we know him.
 - B. The more we know Jesus, the more we abide in him.
 - C. The more we abide in Jesus, the more we obey him.
 - D. The more we obey Jesus, the more we glorify him.
- 5. Christlikeness is a non-negotiable evidence of eternal life.
 - A. This "proof" is both objective and subjective
 - B. When you fail to emulate Jesus your Example, remember Jesus your Advocate and Propitiation
 - C. Walk so closely to your Savior that others see less of you and more of him.
