

Biblical Evidence for Verbal Inspiration:

1. Exo. 24:4 “And Moses wrote **all the words of the LORD**, and rose up early in the morning, and builded an altar under the hill, and twelve pillars, according to the twelve tribes of Israel.”
2. Deut. 6:6-7 “And these **words**, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: 7 And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.”
3. Deut. 12:28 “Observe and hear **all these words** which I command thee, that it may go well with thee, and with thy children after thee for ever, when thou doest that which is good and right in the sight of the LORD thy God.”
4. Josh. 8:34 “And afterward he read **all the words** of the law, the blessings and cursings, according to all that is written in the book of the law.” (see v.35).
5. Josh. 24:26 “And Joshua wrote these **words** in the book of the law of God, and took a great stone, and set it up there under an oak, that was by the sanctuary of the LORD.”
6. 1 Sam. 8:10 “And Samuel told **all the words of the LORD** unto the people that asked of him a king.”
7. Jer. 7:27 “Therefore thou shalt speak **all these words** unto them; but they will not hearken to thee: thou shalt also call unto them; but they will not answer thee.”
8. Ezek. 3:10 “Moreover he said unto me, Son of man, **all my words** that I shall speak unto thee receive in thine heart, and hear with thine ears.”
9. Matt. 4:4 “But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by **every word** that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.”
10. Jn. 8:47 “He that is of God heareth God's **words**: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God.”

Biblical Evidence of Verbal Preservation:

1. Ps. 12:6-7 “The **words of the LORD are pure words**: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times. 7 Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever.”
2. Ps. 78:1, 7 – “Maschil of Asaph. Give ear, O my people, to my law: incline your ears to the **words** of my mouth.” (v.7) “That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but **keep his commandments**.”
3. Isa. 40:8 “The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the **word** of our God shall stand for ever.”
4. Isa. 59:21 “As for me, this is my covenant with them, saith the LORD; My spirit that is upon thee, and my **words** which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the LORD, from henceforth and for ever.”
5. Matt. 24:35 “Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my **words** shall not pass away.”

Biblical Warnings & Exhortations Concerning the Words of God:

1. Pro. 13:13 “Whoso despiseth the word shall be destroyed: but he that feareth the commandment shall be rewarded.”
2. Isa. 66:1-2 “Thus saith the LORD, The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool: where is the house that ye build unto me? and where is the place of my rest? 2 For all those things hath mine hand made, and all those things have been, saith the LORD: but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word.”
3. Jn. 12:48 “He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.”
4. Jn. 17:8 “For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me.”
5. Rev. 22:18-19 “For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: 19 And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.”
