READING GENESIS WITH THE APOSTLES

Description: This is a study of the message of Genesis which focuses on the apostles' interpretation and application of the text as a witness for Christ and instruction for Christ's Church. We will discuss apostolic interpretation as well as the significance of the message of Genesis for Christian faith and practice today.

- Worship and enjoy God with an understanding of His authority as Creator and His grace as a covenant-making and covenant-keeping Lord in Jesus Christ.
- Expound upon the key theological truths of Genesis to edify fellow believers.
- Identify the key movements of the plot in the story of redemption in Genesis to apply the message of the whole book by seeing the unity of its parts.
- Demonstrate how Genesis is a witness for Christ and integrate the witness of Genesis into your evangelism.
- Incorporate assumptions and principles of interpretation used by the apostles into your reading of Scripture.
- Encourage your own faith in the God who promises with the message of Genesis.
