The basic idea behind the English word *insight* is clear—to have insight means to be able to *look* deeply enough *into* some matter, *into* some situation, or *into* someone's life to apprehend the true nature of what is observed. Usually, it refers to the ability to penetrate more deeply into the object, situation, or life than those who, because they lack this skill, are able to see merely what lies on or near the surface. A person with insight is capable of discerning *underlying* factors, *inner* characteristics, and *hidden* causes and relationships.
