God's Vessels of Mercy Romans 9:24–29

God's word has not failed because He is saving the vessels of mercy. God is vindicated because He has the right to chose the vessels of mercy.

even us whom He called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?

- God never *calls* people to condemnation. God never *foreknows* the wicked. God does not *elect* to perish in hell.
- God's calling is His right Romans 9:7; 1:7; 8:28–29
- He wills to call Jews and Gentiles His vessels of mercy Acts 2:39 For the
 promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many
 as the Lord our God will call."

As He says also in Hosea: "I WILL CALL THEM MY PEOPLE, WHO WERE NOT MY PEOPLE, AND HER BELOVED, WHO WAS NOT BELOVED."

"AND IT SHALL COME TO PASS IN THE PLACE WHERE IT WAS SAID TO THEM, 'YOU ARE NOT MY PEOPLE,' THERE THEY SHALL BE CALLED SONS OF THE LIVING GOD."

- In both quotes from Hosea, God is referring to the nation of Israel of whom He set aside in judgment as vessels of wrath to show His glory in judging sin, so that He could then contrast His glory in bestowing grace to vessels of mercy.
- God used Hosea's relationship with his adulterous wife to illustrate His relationship with unfaithful Israel - Hosea 1:1-9
- God promises to reverse His judgment and restore Israel Hosea 1:10; 2:23
- The Holy Spirit applies these promises to Gentile Christians who were not God's
 people but are now God's people 1 Peter 2:10 who once were not a people but
 are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained
 mercy.

Isaiah also cries out concerning Israel: "THOUGH THE NUMBER OF THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL BE AS THE SAND OF THE SEA, THE REMNANT WILL BE SAVED. FOR HE WILL FINISH THE WORK AND CUT IT SHORT IN RIGHTEOUSNESS, BECAUSE THE LORD WILL MAKE A SHORT WORK UPON THE EARTH."

And as Isaiah said before: "UNLESS THE LORD OF SABAOTH HAD LEFT US A SEED, WE WOULD HAVE BECOME LIKE SODOM, AND WE WOULD HAVE BEEN MADE LIKE GOMORRAH."

- These quotations from Isaiah 10:22–23 & 1:9 prove the limitation of God's mercy.
- Rather than seeing the salvation of a remnant of Israel as a failure of God, we should see the salvation of a remnant of Israel as a great act of God glorious mercy and grace upon an undeserving people.
- The fact that Jews are a minority in the church is the same way God has worked in the past. There has always been only a remnant of the true Israel.

God calls out of both Jews and Gentiles His vessels of mercy!

Both Jews and Gentiles begin not as God's people but have now become God's people!

God has elected out of both Jews and Gentiles a remnant to be saved!


