



Ephesus: Historical Context



- Home of 1 of the 7 Great Wonders of the World Temple of Artemis
- **©**Other characteristics
 - Worship of other deities (Artemis, Cybele)
 - ♥ Demon possession
 - ©Practiced sorcery
 - Tree of Life at town square

Artemis of the Ephesians

Another OBSERVATION

In Ephesus:

- The goddess *Artemis* or *Diana* (after Cybele) was a woman
- Both shared "Great Mother of Life" titles
- The church of Virgin Mary was in Ephesus
- There were councils held in Ephesus on how to view Mary
- It was determined that she is/was immaculate
 - **Sinless**
 - Great Mother of God
 - Aka a goddess
- "Artemis of the Ephesians" sure looks similar to "Mary the Mother of God" who was birthed in Ephesus!





Ephesus: Commendations



- ™Deeds, toil, perseverance
- Cannot tolerate evil men
- Test those who call themselves apostles
 - SFound them to be false
- Have perseverance and endured for the gospel and not grown weary
- MHated deeds of the Nicolaitans
 - Similar teachings to Balaam
 - Ate food sacrificed to idols and committed acts of sexual immorality

Ephesus: Criticisms



- Ca Left first love
 - This is prophecy sometime after 95/96AD
- "left" is aphiēme which means to let go from oneself
- ca"first love" is prōtos agapē which means first and foremost love
 - We use this in our vernacular, this person was my "first love"
- TRANSLATION: Just like Jesus told Peter, you will deny Me three times
- Quesus is telling these believers in that church (and likely the angel over it) that they will let themselves go from their first love sometime after the writing of this letter

Ephesus: Exhortations



5a Therefore remember from where you have fallen, and repent and do the deeds you did at first;

- We looked to Ephesians and got a glimpse of the deeds they did at first:
 - S Faithful in Christ Jesus
 - Aspired to know the mystery of His will
 - Their hope in Christ thrived
 - They viewed themselves as God's own possession
 - They prioritized to bring Him glory
 - © Demonstrated love to all the saints
 - Read, studied, meditated, applied Scripture
 - They no longer walked in their former manner of life
 - They did not entertain strange doctrines, myths, and endless genealogies

Ephesus: Exhortations

CONJECTURE: Can angels who joined Satan in the angelic rebellion repent? Probably not, but the angel over this church might have been given a small window of opportunity:

5a Therefore remember from where you [the angel over them] have fallen, and repent and do the deeds you did at first;

Allusions to the fall of angels

Revelation 12:7-8 (After the 7th Trumpet; War in heaven)


7 And there was war in heaven, Michael and his angels waging war with the dragon. The dragon and his angels waged war, 8 and they were not strong enough, and there was no longer a place found for them (Satan and his angels) in heaven.


Ephesus: Promises

Since Ephesus had their own version of the "Tree of Life", Jesus calls their attention to the true "Tree of Life" which is not on earth, but in "the Paradise of God" and that is to come in the new heaven and new earth

All believers will be allowed to eat from Tree of Life which is in the Paradise of God





Smyrna: Historical Context



- Church founder unknown
- City itself had a reputation of being raised from the dead Alexander the Great desired to restore Smyrna to its former glory
- Known for their commodity of myrrh
- Several shrines erected to Greek gods, goddesses, Roman emperors

Smyrna: Commendations



- Experienced tribulation for their faithfulness and poverty
- Though they may not be considered rich economically, they were reminded of being truly rich spiritually

Smyrna: Criticisms



The other one was Philadelphia

Smyrna: Exhortations




- Endure enemies of the gospel
 - Whether it be by the government or Jews (synagogue of Satan)
- - Some will be thrown into prison for 10 days
- Remain faithful at all costs even if it costs them their lives

Smyrna: Promises



- Faithful believers will not experience a 2nd death, but instead receive a crown of life from the risen Lord Jesus!
- Sust as the apostles and believers in Smyrna before us have suffered and endured and were faithful even unto death will be given a crown of life, so too will all believers of all time who are faithful, even if faced with death, will receive the same crown by our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ
- CONJECTURE: Could those who have died for their faith be given a unique crown? Possibly Yes!





Pergamum: Historical Context



- Church founder unknown
- Major producer of parchments
- - Zeus and Athena were prominent figures
- Ancient location of healing, entrenched in idolatry, witchcraft and sorcery
- Antipas (discipled by John) was former bishop and was martyred

Pergamum: Commendations



- Meld fast the gospel
- - Even in the days of Antipas who was killed

Pergamum: Criticisms



Some held teaching of Balak and Nicolaitans

Ate food sacrificed to idols and sexual immorality

Pergamum: Exhortations



- Repent or else they will be treated as the disobedient sons of Israel in the OT who rebelled against God and against Moses who were judged and killed when they held to such teaching


 Baal and Asherah worship

Thyatira: Historical Context



- Church founder unknown
- Known for its dyes, in particular purple
- Had many temples and shrines erected to Greek gods, goddesses, Roman emperors

Thyatira: Commendations

Callove, faith, service and perseverance

□ Deeds of late are greater than at first

Thyatira: Criticisms



- The original Jezebel Queen of Israel influenced King Ahab and the people of Israel to engage in Baal and Asherah worship
 - Eating food sacrificed to idols
 - Sexual immorality
- Apparently there was a self proclaimed prophetess who continued to teach and lead the people of Israel astray
 - There are also prophetic implications concerning the state of Israel and the world during the end times



Thyatira: Exhortations



- □ Jesus also exhorts them to remain faithful and proclaim the gospel until He comes

Thyatira: Promises



- Faithful believers will be given authority over the nations during the millennial kingdom
 - Currently Christians are ruled and dominated by the world. The time will come and the script will be flipped where Christians under Christ will rule and dominate the nations
- - When Jesus promises to give him the morning star, He is promising that He will grant him authority over the nations when Jesus returns to earth
