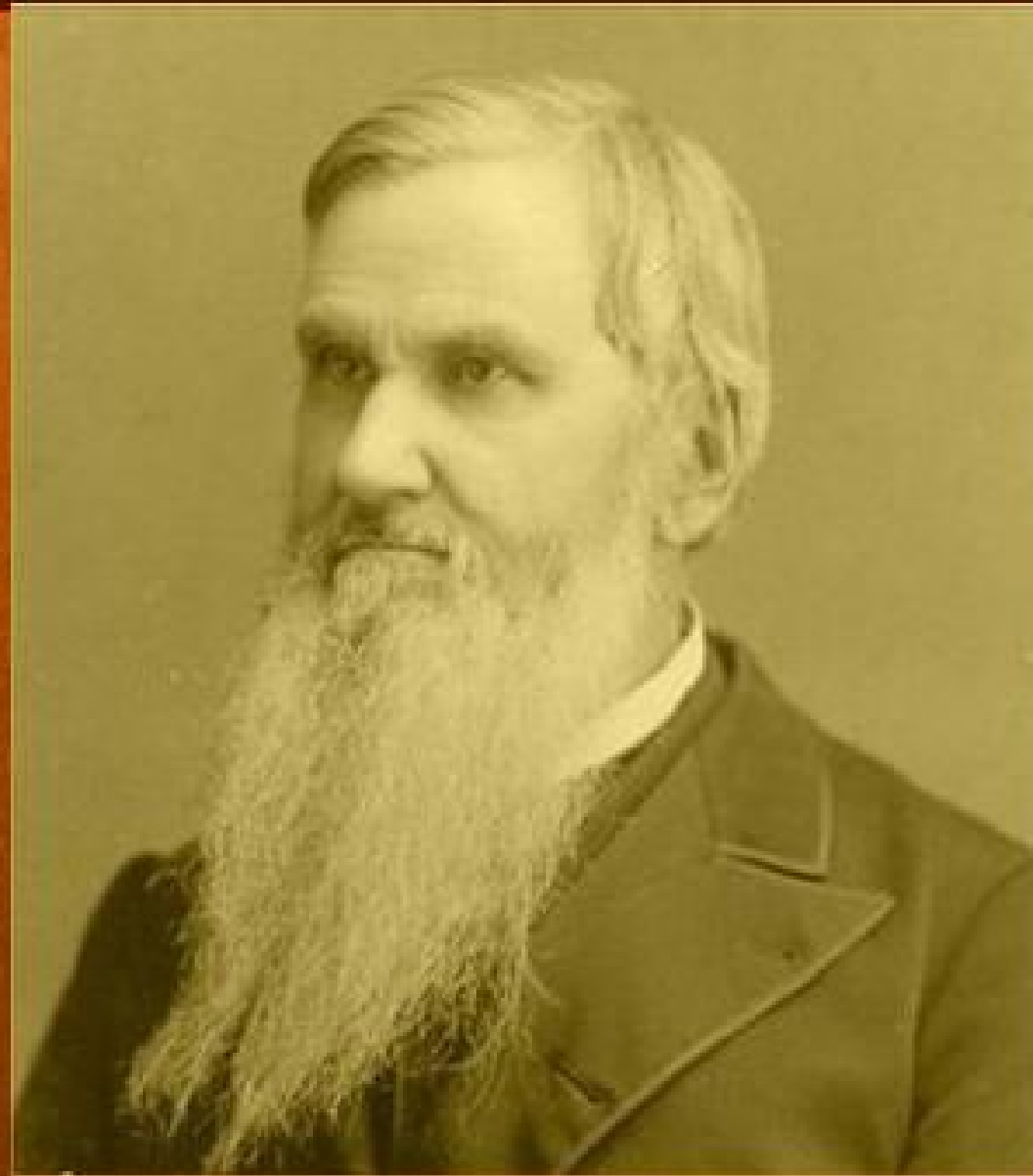

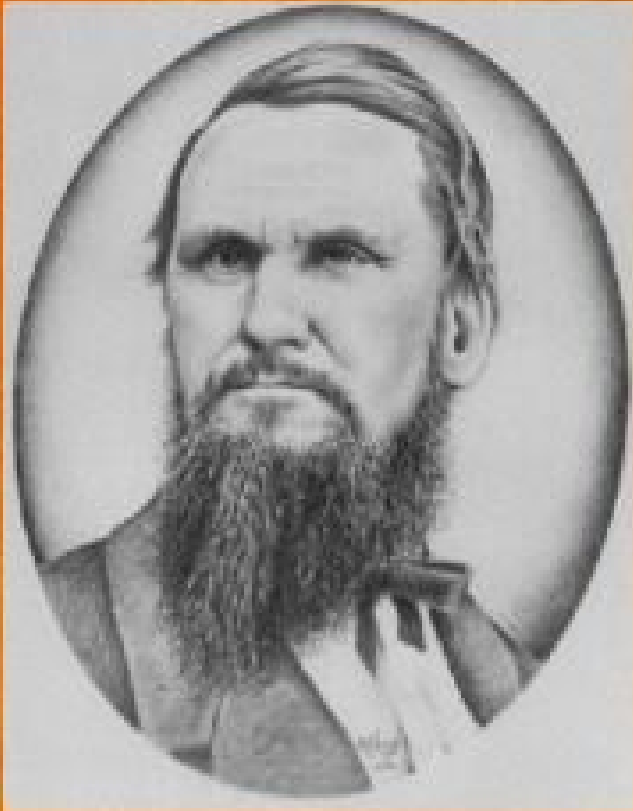

## Dabney Biography



Born March 5th 1820 - Age 13 his father died.

(June 1, 1836—September 27, 1837 student and Hampden Sydney College

(October, 1837—December 9, 1839 – returns to help his widowed mother on the farm.

(November, 1844—May. 1846.) Student and Union Seminary.

(July, 1847—August, 1853.) Pastors Church in Tinkling Spring

(August, 1853— 1883.) Professor at Union Seminary. Spring Of 1862.—Tendered Office Of Chief Of Staff To General Thomas Jackson

(June, 1869-1874.) Settled In Virginia As Teacher, Writer, Man And Pastor.

(1883-1894.) Moves to Texas to teach at the U of Texas in Austin

1898 – Death and burial next to his three deceased sons.

Dabney enters college at 16 years and 3 months

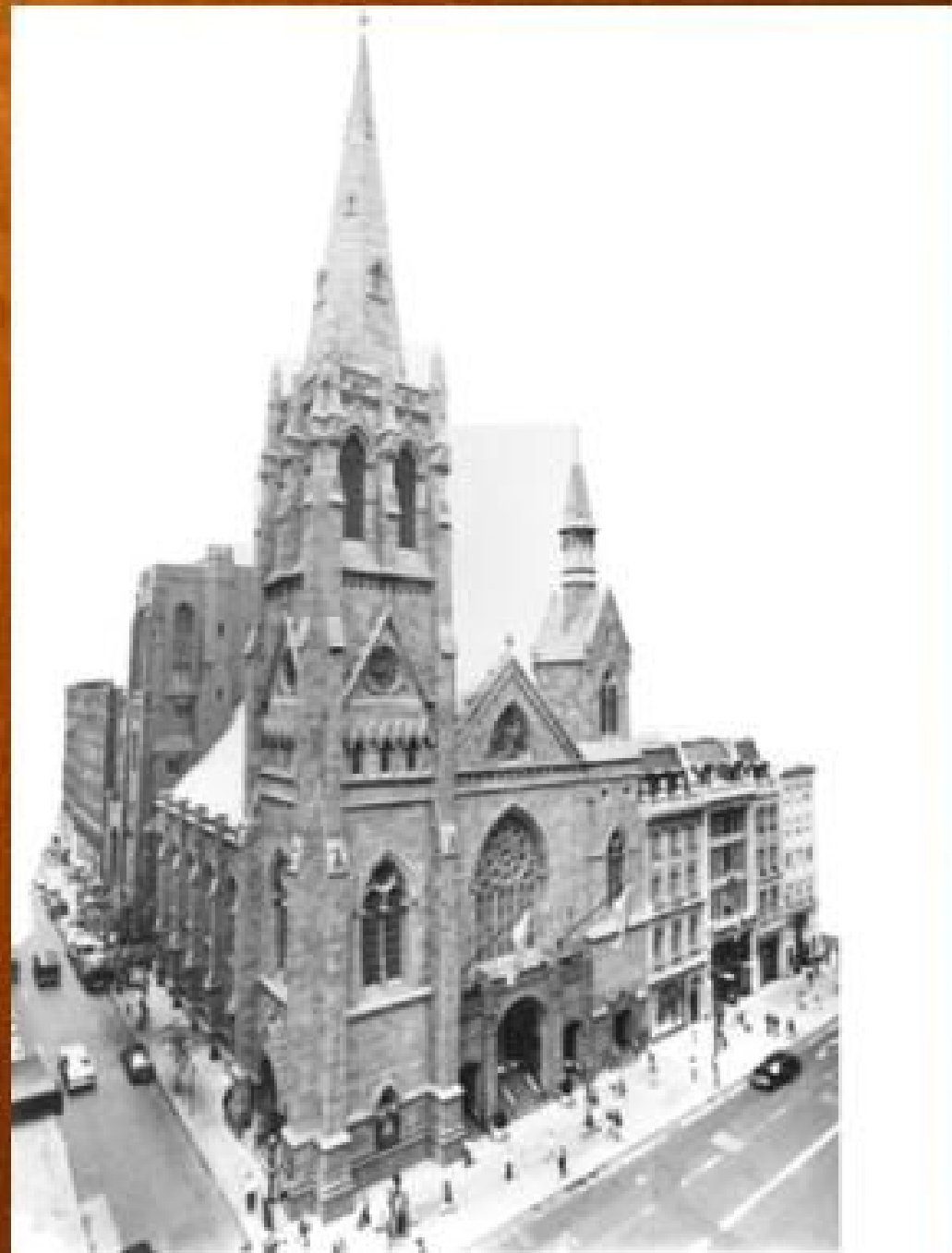

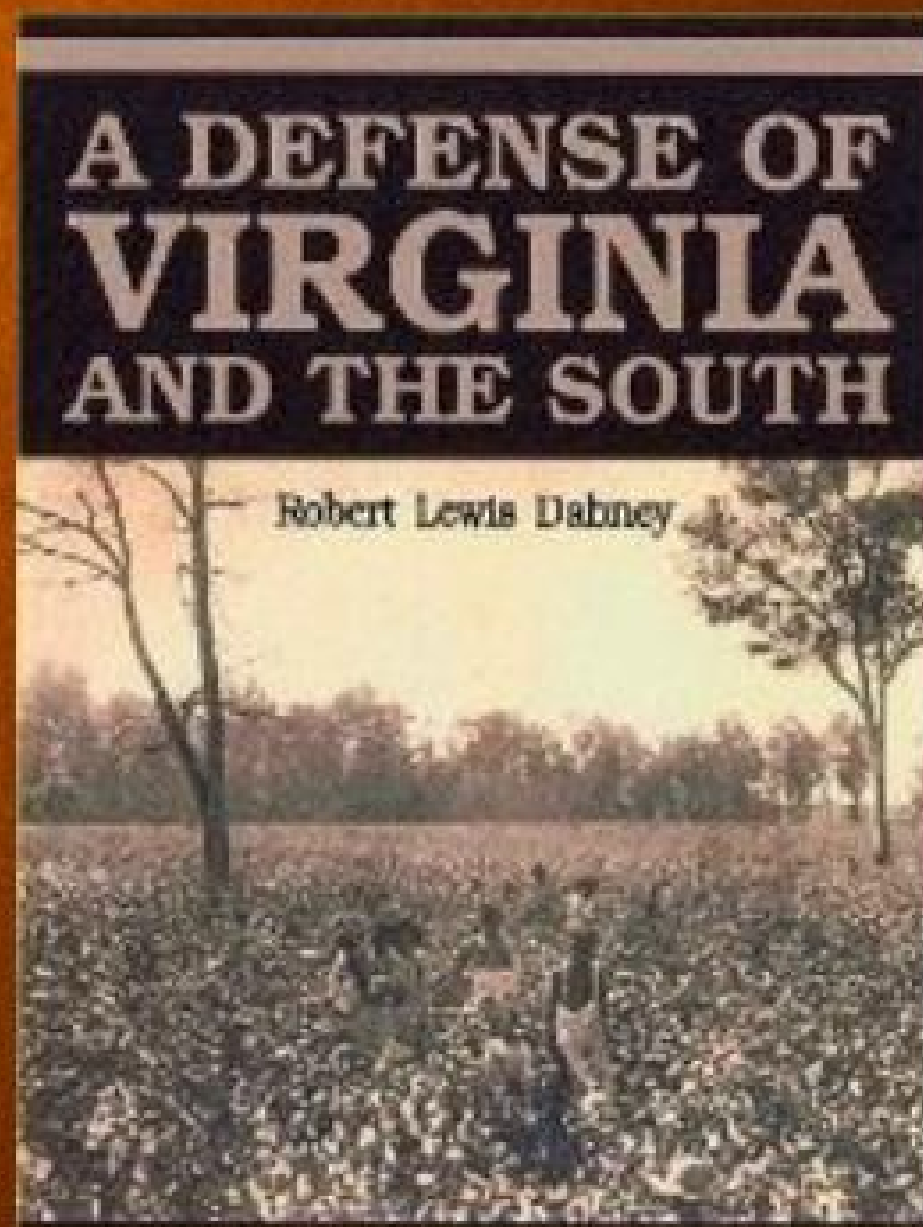
