1. Why is a biblical understanding of Jesus' humanity essential to our view of Him as "our Passover?"
2. What does it mean to be a "servant of the Lord" in 2020? Practically, what does that look like in our busy, day-to-day lives?
3. We don't often talk in terms of the "Name" of the Lord. In this increasingly pluralistic culture, should we emphasize it more in our conversations about God? Why or why not?
4. Consider and discuss Jesus' mindset (as much as we can as fallen beings) as He sang vv. 5-8 in light of what we know awaited Him in just a few short hours.
5. How do those same verses impact the understanding of our own redemption by the God Whose "glory is above the heavens" but Who "humbles Himself" to lift sinners "from the dust?"
