James wisely chooses a transitional compromise.

Revelation is progressive. John 16:12

The primary issue being addressed is *fellowship*, the preservation of unity, not enforcing morality.

To the Jew, teaching the law of Moses to Gentiles was fulfilling God's call on them to proselytize.

The decision by James is an appeal from *love* to abstain from things that are appalling to Jews.

The issue in the Church today is the reverse of what they were dealing with at the Jerusalem Council.

Then, new Gentile believers were exhorted not to engage in things that might offend the Jewish Christian.

Today, spiritually mature believers are exhorted not to engage in things that might offend new believers.

Freedom in Christ does not mean absolute autonomy to live any way we want to.
