The Remedy for Apostasy (Hebrews 3:12-15)

- "Beware" the word strongly signals that there is danger nearby
- The danger is the sin of denying God, specifically denying Christ
- Evil is the antithesis of God –unbelief turning away from God
- Jewish Christians in danger of turning from the Gospel back to OC
- Apostle develops argument: Jesus superior to prophets, angels, Moses
- From 2:7-11 the apostle gives the witness of the Holy Spirit on Israel:
- 1. They did not hear His voice: would not listen and believe (v.7)
- 2. Their hearts grew hard in their rebellion during their trial in the wilderness (v.8)
- 3. They tested God for 40 years in their unbelief in the face of God's great works (v.9)
- 4. From hardness of hearts & unbelief strayed in their heart to worship idols (v10)
- 5. They proved they didn't know God & unable to enter God's salvation & rest (11)

I. A Serious Warning: Beware (3:12, 12b)

- An evil heart of unbelief leading you to fall away from the living God
- > Jeremiah 17:5 "cursed is the man who trusts in man"
- Flipside Jeremiah 17: 7-8 "Blessed is the man who trusts the Lord"
- > Jeremiah 2:13 my people committed two evils
- Evil unbelieving heart leads to a heart deceived by sin & hardened in sin

II. A Wonderful Exhortation and Encouragement (3:13 a, b, 14)

- "Exhort one another daily"
- "For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end"
- Galatians 3:1-3; 2 Corinthians 11:3
