Abrahamic Covenant: Great Nation, Everlasting possession of Land, Blessing to the world.

Made with Abraham, but blessings are for his descendants. Isaac Not Ishmael or 6 sons of Keturah Jacob Not Esau Twelve Tribes of Israel.

Pre-requisite to blessing. Saving transforming faith.

Blessing aspect of the A.C. is fulfilled. Galatians 3:8,16

Israel's disobedience does not nullify any part of the A.C. Galatians 3:17–19, 21

O.C. cannot impart life.

N.C. promises to impart life. Why is the NC needed? Jeremiah 32:24, 26–28, 36–44

## God's Rejection of Israel.

## God has rejected Israel because God is faithful to His word. Leviticus 26:1–46

God's curses come as a result of disobedience. Does disobedience always result immediately by God's curses? No.

Joshua 24; 2 Kings 18:1, 3–4

Do not confuse God's blessings that He gives the nation of Israel with His full acceptance of them as having expressed national faith in His promises. **Psalm 50:16–23** 

God has rejected Israel beca Jeremiah 2:4–13; 5:30–31;	<i>use they have rejected Him.</i> Appalling rejection
Jeremiah 32:17, 21–24, 26–34	Perpetual rejection.
Jeremiah 15:1–6	<b>Depleting rejection.</b> God's longsuffering has been depleted.
