8 Some insights about heaven we want to consider in future studies in this series

- "Trying to develop an appetite for a disembodied existence in a nonphysical Heaven is like trying to develop an appetite for gravel." ... "We do not desire to eat gravel. Why? Because God did not design us to eat gravel." Randy Alcorn
