Examine the Scriptures (Be Berean!)

- Disciples told to they would see Jesus in Galilee Mat 28:1-7; Mark 16;1-8
- An earlier provision of a miraculous catch of fish: Luke 5:1-10
- Jesus' intention to make His disciples fishers of men: Mat 4:19
- Jesus' first invitation for His disciples to "come" and be with Him: John 1:39 and context

Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

• **Community Group Discussion:** Jesus had already appeared to His disciples twice before. Why did he appear to them again (besides to have conversation with Peter which we will look at next week)? What was accomplished by having breakfast with them as He did? How do you think the resurrection changed things for Jesus' disciples? How has and how should the resurrection change how we are, think and live as Jesus' disciple today?

Memory & Meditation Verse

¹² Jesus *said to them, "Come and have breakfast." None of the disciples ventured to question Him, "Who are You?" knowing that it was the Lord. ¹³ Jesus *came and *took the bread and *gave *it* to them, and the fish likewise. ¹⁴ This is now the third time that Jesus was manifested to the disciples, after He was raised from the dead. John 21:12-14
