First, Prepare for Revival by Obedience

- **1Sam.15:22** And Samuel said, "Has the Lord as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to listen than the fat of rams.
- **Heb.5:8** Although he, Christ, was a Son, he learned obedience through what he suffered.
- **Phil.2:8** And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.
- **Heb.12:1–2** Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, ² looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.
