Plan to Memorize Philippians 2:14-18

Day One: Read Philippians 2:14 out loud ten times, looking at each word as if photographing it with your eyes. Then cover the verse and recite it ten times. You're done for the day.

Day Two: Day One's verse first! Recite yesterday's verse, Philippians 12:14 ten times. Look at the verse if you need to, just to refresh your memory. Next, do the new verse. Read Philippians 2:15 out loud ten times, looking at each word as if photographing it with your eyes. Then cover the page and recite that verse ten times. You're done for the day.

Day Three: Day Two's verse first. Recite Philippians 2:15 ten times. Look at the verse to refresh your memory as needed. Old verses next, altogether: Recite Philippians 2:14-15 together one time. On to the new verse, read Philippians 2:16 out loud ten times, looking at each word as if photographing it with your eyes. Cover the page and recite Philippians 2:16 ten times. You're done for the day.

Day four: Day Three's verse first. Recite Philippians 2:16 ten times. Look at the verse only to refresh your memory. Old verses next: Recite Philippians 2:14-16 together one time. Now, do the new verse. Read Philippians 2:17 out loud ten times looking at each word as if photographing it with your eyes. Cover the page and recite Philippians 2:17 ten times. You're done for the day.

Day Five: Day Four's verse first. Recite Philippians 2:17 ten times. Look at the verse only to refresh your memory. Old verses next: Recite Philippians 2:14-17 together one time. Now, do the new verse. Read Philippians 2:18 out loud ten times looking at each word as if photographing it with your eyes. Cover the page and recite Philippians 2:18 ten times. You're done for the day.

<u>Day Six:</u> Recite Philippians 2:14-18. Look at the verse only to refresh your memory.

- 14 Do all things without grumbling or disputing;
- so that you will prove yourselves to be blameless and innocent, children of God above reproach in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you dappear as lights in the world,
- holding fast the word of life, so that in the day of Christ I will have reason to glory because I did not run in vain nor toil in vain.
- 17 But even if I am being poured out as a drink offering upon the sacrifice and service of your faith, I rejoice and share my joy with you all.
- You too, *I urge you*, rejoice in the same way and share your joy with me.¹
