- Trend today to adopt worldly methodology to evangelize the lost
- Jesus never presented himself to people as an "Add-On"
- Salvation involves radically transformation of life
- Jesus Christ as the "light of the world" leads us from the realm of darkness to the realm of spiritual light, and in the process, He transforms our lives!

Transformed by the Light!

A. Our Former Lifestyle: "Walking as the rest of the Gentiles walk"

Self-centered—Ephesians 4:17 "futility of their minds"

Scripturally-blinded—Ephesians 4:18 "understanding darkened"

- Darkened to the meaning of God's word.—1 Corinthians 2:14
- Darkness implies both ignorance and immorality.—2 Timothy 3:7; Romans 1:21

Spiritually-insensitive—Ephesians 4:18 "the blindness of their heart"

- "blindness" should be translated "hardness of heart"
- "Hard hearts" are unresponsive to the truth, not due to ignorance but rather refusal to respond to God's warnings and revelation.
 - "Alienated from the life of God"
 - 2) "Due to the ignorance that is in them"

Sensual-Sinful Lifestyle—Ephesians 4:19 "past feeling, have given themselves over..."

- "past feeling" -- Gr. Text says, "who feeling no pain"—that is, no shame, no remorse
- Without pain or remorse, they give themselves over to...
 - Lewdness—absence of all moral standards
 - Uncleanness—general moral perversity and wrong doing
 - Greediness—a continual lust for more
- Sin does not satisfy—the law of diminishing returns

Our New Lifestyle: "Walking as children of light"

Instead of being self-centered, we are now CHRIST-CENTERED—Ephesians 4:20

- To "learn Christ" is to know Christ, to become one of his disciples.—Matthew 11:28-29
- Our new life become Christ-centered. Colossians 3:3-4; Galatians 2:20

Instead of being Scripturally-blinded, we are now SCRIPTURALLY-TAUGHT—Ephesians 4:21 Note the Progression

- "heard Him"—Romans 10:17
- "taught by Him"—teachability
- "the trust as in Jesus"—strong convictions

Instead of being Spiritual-Insensitive, we are now SPIRITUALLY RESPONSIVE—Ephesians 4:22-24

- The PROCESS explained
 - We are to PUT OFF the old man—our former conduct. Colossians 3:5, 8-9
 - We must PUT ON the new man "created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness" The KEY: We need new INPUT-- "be renewed in the spirit of your mind" Colossians 3:10
- The PROCESS illustrated 2 Corinthians 3:14-18
- The PROCESS unfinished—Philippians 3:12-14

Instead of being sensual, sinful, we are SPIRITUAL, LIGHT-LIKE—Ephesians 5:8-10

- The production of "fruit of light"—Ephesians 5:8-9
 - 'goodness" or "moral excellence"
 - "righteousness" or "spiritual excellence"
 - "truth" or "personal excellence" or integrity
- The pursuit of developing light-like qualities—Ephesians 5:10
