
3. Fundamental presupposition of faith, v3

³ By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are **seen** were **not** made of things which are **visible**.

- a. Creator of All Things: Seen & Unseen *form, function, fitting together, future
- b. His Word is All-wise, All-powerful
- c. Intelligent Design evident in universe
- d. Faith is reasonable, not blind
