Hebrews 13:10-14

Introduction: John 19:13-16: The Praetorium, Via Dolorosa & Golgotha

Context: Hebrews 13:7-9: The superiority of the New Covenant

- **I. Hebrews 13:10-11:** *We have an altar* (sacrifice) that is greater than that of *Yom Kippor* (Lev 16:15-17)
- **II. Hebrews 13:11-12:** *Outside the camp:* From *Yom Kippor* to *Golgotha*

Capital punishment (outside the gate) in First Century Judea

Outside the camp in Jewish Law (Lev 24:13, Num 19:1-3, Lev 6:10-11, Ez 43:21, Deut 23:12-14, Dead Sea Scrolls, Essenes, Eden)

The irony: Jesus taken *outside the camp* to sanctify His people

III. Hebrews 13:13: Let us go to him outside the camp and bear reproach

The true holy place: Jerusalem? Or something else?

A call to First Century Jews to forsake the old order

A call to us to take up our cross and follow Jesus

IV. Hebrews 13:14: For here we have no lasting city ...
