In every crisis, those in covenant relationship with God should quietly rely on God—and God *alone*—until he fulfills every promise to rescue us from our enemies.

— How Psalm 62 Teaches Us to Rely on God —

1. Relying on God most fundamentally involves committing your whole life to God.

What is faith?

Faith is personal conviction about God's word that results in personal life commitment to God himself.

Faith involves knowledge of, agreement with, and reliance on God's word. And true faith is repentant, life-changing, and enduring.
