

# **Raised to Shame and Everlasting Contempt**

## **Daniel 12:2**

### **1. All people will be resurrected**

*Acts 24:15 there will be a resurrection of both the just and the unjust.*

*John 5:28-29 An hour is coming when all who are in the tombs will hear his voice and come out, those who have done good to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil to the resurrection of judgment.*

Soul sleep? Phil. 1:23; 2 Cor. 5:8; Luke 23:43; Hebrews 12:23; Revelation 6-7

Why are all people resurrected?

*Revelation 20:11-21:1 Then I saw a great white throne and him who was seated on it. From his presence earth and sky fled away, and no place was found for them. And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Then another book was opened, which is the book of life. And the dead were judged by what was written in the books, according to what they had done. And the sea gave up the dead who were in it, Death and Hades gave up the dead who were in them, and they were judged, each one of them, according to what they had done. Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire. Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more.*

*Hebrews 9:27 it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment.*

## **2. Some people will be resurrected to shame & contempt**

### **a) This shame/contempt is unnatural**

**i) We cause it by discarding God (Romans 1:21, 23)**

### e) **This shame/contempt is the judgment of God**

Matthew 10:28 *Fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell.*

### 3. **This shame/contempt is redeemable**

Mark 9:12 *How is it written of the Son of Man that he should suffer many things and be treated with contempt?*

Luke 23:11 *Herod with his soldiers treated him with contempt and mocked him.*

Psalm 22:6 *But I am a worm and not a man, scorned by mankind and despised by the people.*

Isaiah 53:3-6 *He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not. Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.*

Hebrews 12:1-2 *Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.*

Zephaniah 3:14-20 <sup>14</sup> *Sing aloud, O daughter of Zion; shout, O Israel! Rejoice and exult with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem!* <sup>15</sup> *The Lord has taken away the judgments against you; he has cleared away your enemies. The King of Israel, the Lord, is in your midst; you shall never again fear evil.* <sup>16</sup> *On that day it shall be said to Jerusalem: "Fear not, O Zion; let not your hands grow weak.* <sup>17</sup> *The Lord your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save; he will rejoice over you with gladness; he will quiet you by his love; he will exult over you with loud singing.* <sup>18</sup> *I will gather those of you who mourn for the festival, so that you will no longer suffer reproach.* <sup>19</sup> *Behold, at that time I will deal with all your oppressors. And I will save the lame and gather the outcast, and I will change their shame into praise and renown in all the earth.* <sup>20</sup> *At that time I will bring you in, at the time when I gather you together; for I will make you renowned and praised among all the peoples of the earth, when I restore your fortunes before your eyes," says the Lord.*
