

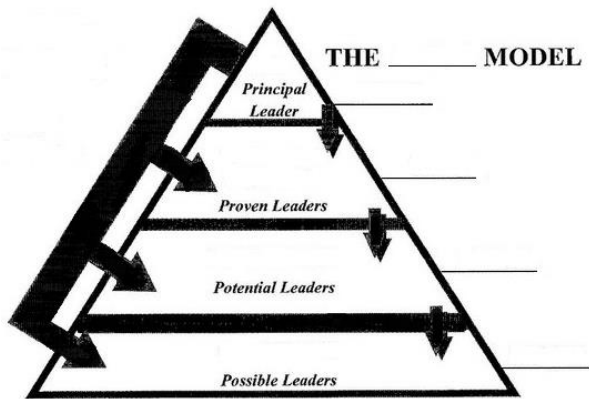
“Peter, James and John: Disciples”
