Dr. Paul and Laura Chinchen and African Bible Colleges

Dr. Paul D. Chinchen is the President of African Bible Colleges and oversees the mission's work in Malawi, Liberia and Uganda. Paul and his wife Laura have been missionaries with African Bible Colleges for over 30 years. The Chinchens have five children, three of whom were born in Africa. African Bible Colleges operates three Christian universities in Africa, as well as four Christian radio stations, a television station, a Mission Hospital, and a Christian academy that runs from Kindergarten through 12th grade.

In August 2016, United Christian Academy was opened to serve local children from financially disadvantaged households with a full-time Christian education and support system.
