- Freedom To Enter The Presence Of God Has Been Given To Us Through The Sacrifice Of Jesus The Savior!
  - For He Is "The Way" John 14:6
  - Early Church Called "The Way" In Acts
  - The Way Was Hidden & Veiled Until It Was Broken Down, And His Blood Flowed To Reveal The Path We Would Walk! It Is A Visible, Living Way Constantly Being Kept Up By The Lord Himself!

        - In Your Walk With / Worship Of / Witness For God!
        - 1 Corinthians 15:58 "Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast,

unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord!"

- Hebrews 6:17-20 - "Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath: 18 That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us: 19 Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil; 20 Whither the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec!"
